Have you ever walked into a home and instantly felt at ease?

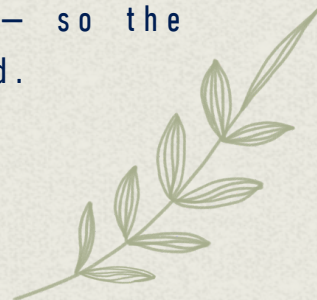
Not because of how it looked —

HOMES DON'T NEED TO "BREATHE."

You've probably heard that homes need to breathe.

But that's not actually how buildings work.

A well-built home should be airtight — not leaky.

What matters is controlled ventilation.

Think of it like your skin.
It allows moisture to escape...
but protects what's inside.

When air, heat, and moisture are controlled properly,
you create a home that feels stable, dry, and healthy.

This is one of the core principles behind Passive House design.

THE HIDDEN LAYER OF YOUR HOME.

The biggest risks in a home aren't always visible.

They're built into the structure itself.

Moisture trapped where it shouldn't be.

Poor insulation allowing temperature swings.

Air leakage bringing in humidity and pollutants.

These are the things that lead to:

- Mould
- Discomfort
- Long-term damage

And often, they go unnoticed for years.

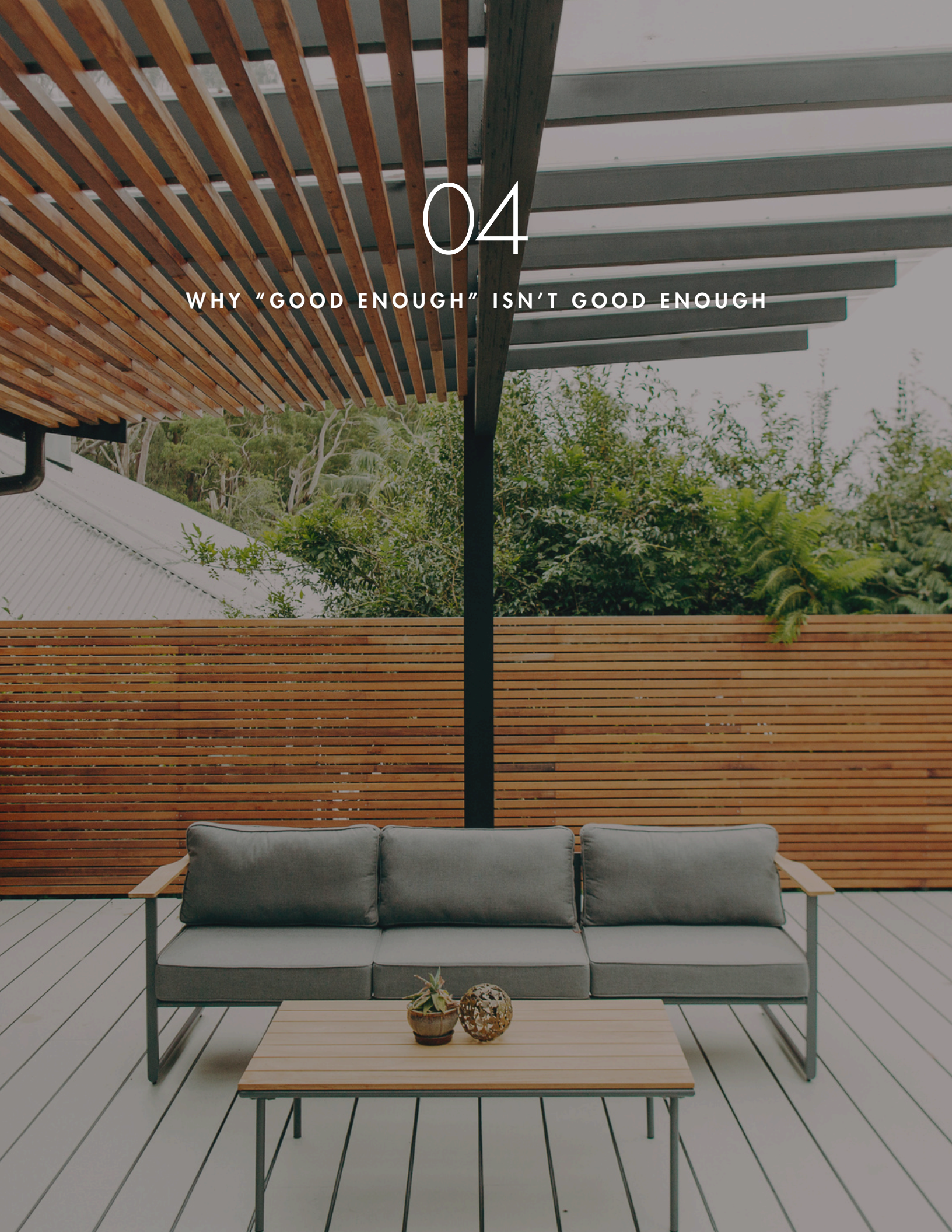

- Well-sealed, thermally efficient windows

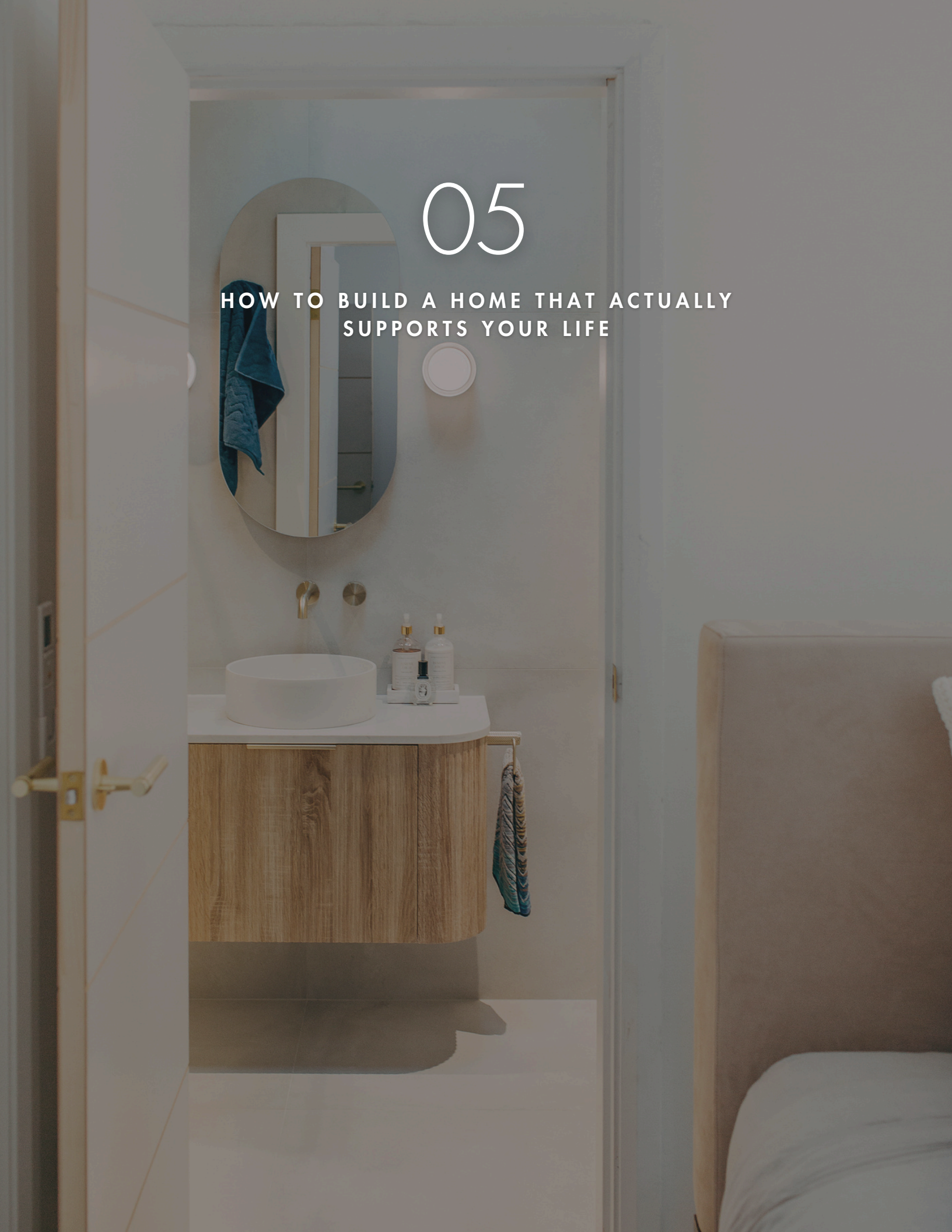
The result?
