The color vinyl banners cost \$75 for new banners, or residents can also fly last year's banners for \$25 each, to help cover the cost of the lift rental and replacement straps.

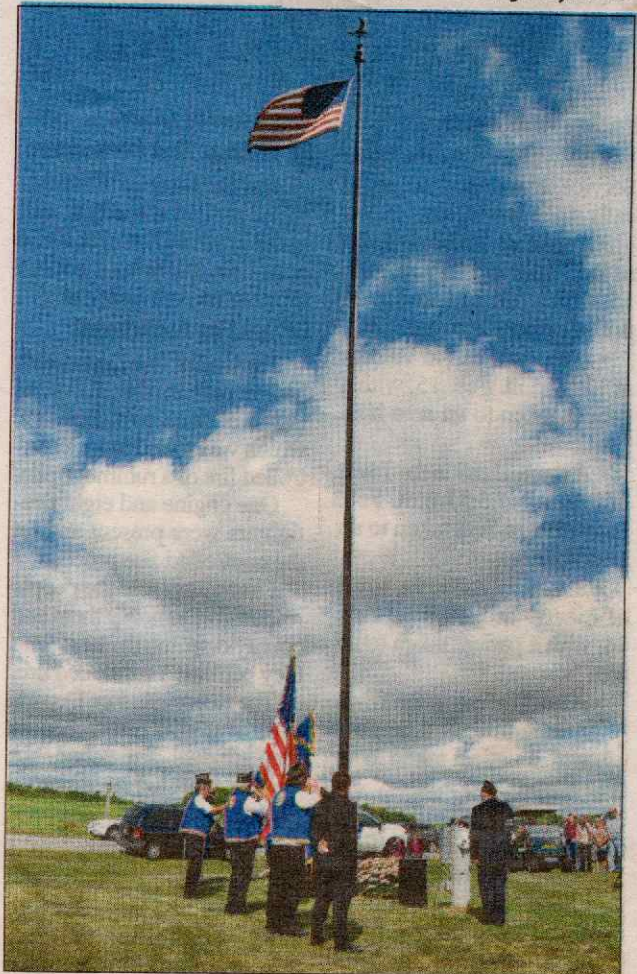
Applications are available

## Fundraiser seeks to buy new pole

The Meeme Liberty Pole at the intersections of County Highway XX and County Highway M in the Town of Meeme will soon have a secondary, modern 60-foot industrial flagpole.

St. Nazianz American Legion Post and Sons of the American Legion Squadron 477 are running a capital campaign to raise funds for the second flagpole. The post has

a goal to raise \$25,000 for a flagpole with an internal winch system and lighting.

The post hopes to dedicate the new flagpole on July 4, the United States of America's 250th birthday. A flag will only fly on that pole on holidays and Flag Day.
