

PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy notice for Legacy Network (“we,” “us,” or “our”) describes how and why we might collect, store, use, and/or share (“process”) your information when you use our website at www.legacynetwork.com (the “Website”). - What personal information do we process? We may process personal information depending on how you interact with our Website.

WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

Personal Information You Disclose to Us. We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide, including your name, email address, phone number, and any other details you submit through contact forms or account registration. You are responsible for ensuring your information remains accurate and up to date. Certain data may be classified as Sensitive Personal Information under applicable law, including California law. We process such data only as necessary to:

- Provide and secure our Website
 - Prevent fraud and comply with legal obligations
- We do not use Sensitive Personal Information to infer characteristics about users.

Information Automatically Collected

We automatically collect certain technical data when you visit our Website, including:

- IP address
- Device and browser characteristics
- Operating system
- Language preferences
- Referring URLs
- Usage and interaction data

This data is used for security, analytics, and Website functionality.

HOW DO WE PROCESS YOUR INFORMATION?

We process your information to:

- Provide, operate, and improve our Website
- Communicate with you
- Ensure security and prevent fraud
- Comply with legal obligations

We process personal information based on applicable legal grounds, including:

- Your consent
- Performance of a contract
- Compliance with legal obligations
- Legitimate business interests

We do not use your information for materially different purposes without notice or consent.

WHEN AND WITH WHOM DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

We do not sell or share your personal information for advertising purposes.

We may share information with trusted service providers, including:

- Hosting providers
- Analytics providers

These providers are contractually restricted from using your data for any purpose other than providing services on our behalf.

DO WE USE COOKIES AND TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES?

We may use cookies and similar technologies for functionality, analytics, and security. These technologies do not collect personally identifiable information.

IS YOUR INFORMATION TRANSFERRED INTERNATIONALLY?

Your information may be processed in countries outside your own. Where this occurs, we implement reasonable safeguards consistent with applicable law.

HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

We retain personal information only as long as necessary based on:

- The nature of the data
- Legal and regulatory requirements
- Business and operational needs

DATA SECURITY

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect your personal information. However, no system can be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

In the event of a data breach affecting your personal information, we will notify affected users as required by applicable law.

DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM MINORS?

We do not knowingly collect, solicit, or process personal information from individuals under the age of 18. If we become aware of such data, we will promptly delete it.
