of *Way of Life Literature*, a 45-year-old
preaching and teaching ministry.

In 1973, when he was 23 years old and
living a 'hippie' lifestyle, drugs, having
hitchhiked across America, and
joined a Hindu meditation society,

Brother Cloud was saved by the
marvelous grace of Jesus Christ.

Right away he became an eager student
of the holy Bible and felt the call to
preach and teach God's Word.

Within six months, he had printed his
first book on a biblical theme.

Brother Cloud married his wife, Linda,
in 1976, and God has given them four
children and nine grandchildren.

The Clouds have had a pioneer missionary
church planting ministry in Asia since
the late 1970s. *Way of Life Literature* has
published roughly 200 books in fifteen

magazine, which began in 1984.



"Many men turn aside from religion, where their (self) interest would be compromised. If I see two men walking together, I cannot tell who is the master of the dog that is behind, but I shall discover directly; one of them will turn to the right and the other to the left; now I shall know who is the master of the dog, for when it comes to the *turning point* the dog will go with its master and leave the stranger. 1. Sheep have no sense of direction; Sheep get lost easily.
2. Sheep need directions and leadership.
3. No creature strays more easily than a 'lost' sheep.
4. Sheep need to be sheared for their own good - they are dirtier than pigs. Their wool gets wiry, dirty, matted, infested with worms - they begin to *move slowly*; they *easily get entangled* in brush and branches.
5. Sheep like to be sheared ! They jump for joy !
6. Sheep *follow* the shepherd - they do *not* walk *ahead* of them. "*Sheep are led, Goats are driven.*"
7. Sheep are very timid - they are afraid of rushing streams and waterfalls; no matter how thirsty, they will not drink near these places, *Psalm 32:2*
8. Sheep will *not* drink stagnant water, but pigs and hogs will.
9. Sheep cannot find their own 'fold' - they will continue bleating even if within hearing distance of the flock - they will still go the wrong way.
10. Sheep cannot swim. ('*Stay in the boat!*')
11. Sheep are bothered by insects; it's a big problem.
12. A *hungry* sheep will *not* lie down; only on a full stomach.
13. Sheep recognize and know their own shepherd's voice, and will answer to it, *John 10:4, 5, 27* "They can actually recognize the people who take care of them and will follow them around."
14. Natural enemies of sheep are - wolves, coyotes, dogs, cougars, bear, vultures, fowls of the air, etc.
15. Wolves make sheep nervous - when sheep are grazing comfortably in the pasture, and all of a sudden they get a scent of a wolf, although they cannot see him, they know he is there.
16. Sheep have no natural defenses - they must huddle together; this confuses wolves and other predators. "When they are attacked by wolves, there is only one way they can protect themselves. They will draw together into a gigantic white mound during an attack.






"I have gone astray like a lost sheep"



"All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way."

- *Isaiah 53:6*



- The wolf won't attack this white mound, but will go after other prey - often the sheep outside the flock and on its own.
17. Goats can be mixed with sheep, but not without turmoil.
 18. If sheep fall on their backs, they are not able to get up again - this is called being 'cast'. If not rescued, they will die on their backs, *Psalm 36:11-12, 42:5-6*
Why do sheep 'cast'? a. Looking for a soft and comfortable spot; b. Having too much wool; c. Being too fat.
 19. Sheep become *stressed* when isolated - they are 'social' beings.
 20. Sick sheep - "Those who raise sheep know the sick sheep is the only one that does *not* like the flock. He wanders off by himself behind the bush and dies. The healthy sheep all like to be where the other sheep are."
 21. "Sheep are not meant to carry burdens. You will never see sheep carrying a pack on their back. Other animals are good for carrying things, but not sheep. They were *not* meant to carry a heavy load. In fact, they would be crushed under such a weighty burden." (*Psalm 55:22*)
