"Whoso diggeth a pit shall fall therein: and he that rolleth a stone, it will return upon him." (v 27)

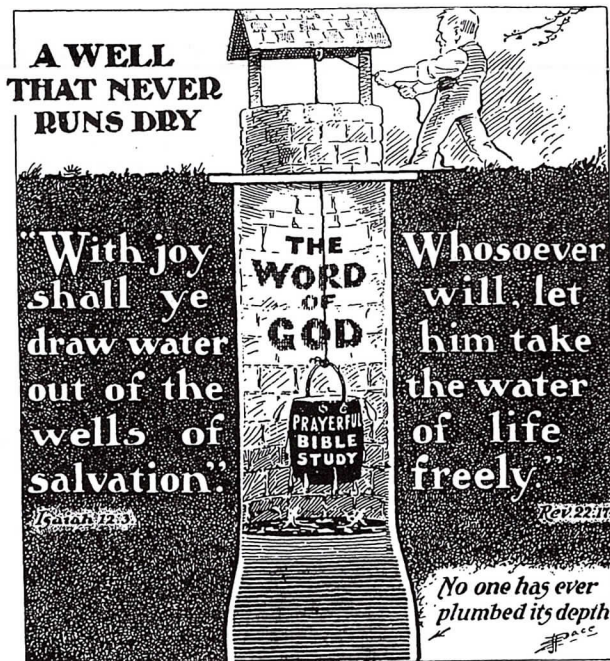
"No doubt most every reader will immediately respond to this 'trap' 'Me? Never!' But, nonetheless, God has included among the snares to be avoided the 'pit' intended for others but which, in the end, entraps the one who dug it in the first place. Subtle attitudes of the heart fall into this category, and we might be more vulnerable to it than first imagined.

"We can 'dig a pit' for another by outwardly defaming, discrediting, or hindering that person but also through our inward thoughts of the heart known only to the Lord. The results, however, are the same. God will never allow any of His children to purposely injure or stumble another and get away with it.

Yes, in addition to dealing with the sin itself, God has established the divine principle that what evil we wish for another will eventually fall upon ourselves.

Another manifestation of this kind of 'snare' is when we inwardly harbor ill will toward someone, or smile smugly within, when a Christian brother or sister in Christ stumbles. The natural reaction of the flesh is to glory in our own supposed steadfastness when we hear of another who has fallen.

Since God is displeased if the saint rejoices when an enemy stumbles, (Proverbs 24:17), imagine how He must view our similar attitude when a fellow believer falls. Such attitudes only result in digging a pit for ourselves into which we will eventually fall!" - Dennis Costella, 'Snare to be Avoided'

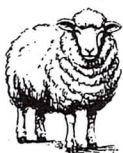

"Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation."

The Rule of PRIVATE INTERPRETATION ... The Truth of God's Word must not be understood from an isolated passage.

When the correct interpretation is used in the Bible, there are no contradictions in it ... in fact, that is a test of correct interpretation.

1. The cumulative revelation of all the Scriptures must be compiled on any specific doctrine;
2. No part of Scripture is to be interpreted apart from or isolated from the rest of the Bible related to that specific subject;
3. All Scripture must agree with the rest of the Bible;
4. If there is a passage which contradicts another passage, there is some misunderstanding about the interpretation;
5. Don't settle a doctrine on a single, isolated interpretation;
6. To be sure you have the truth on any given subject or doctrine, make sure that you have all the verses of the Bible that speak on that subject;
7. Many false understandings and heresies arise from a false, isolated interpretation of a single verse.

Israel - Romans 9:1-6

In this passage, Paul concludes the matter ... What about Israel in the gospel-church age? Has God's Word pertaining to Israel failed? Does the Israel that exists today have no future with God?
