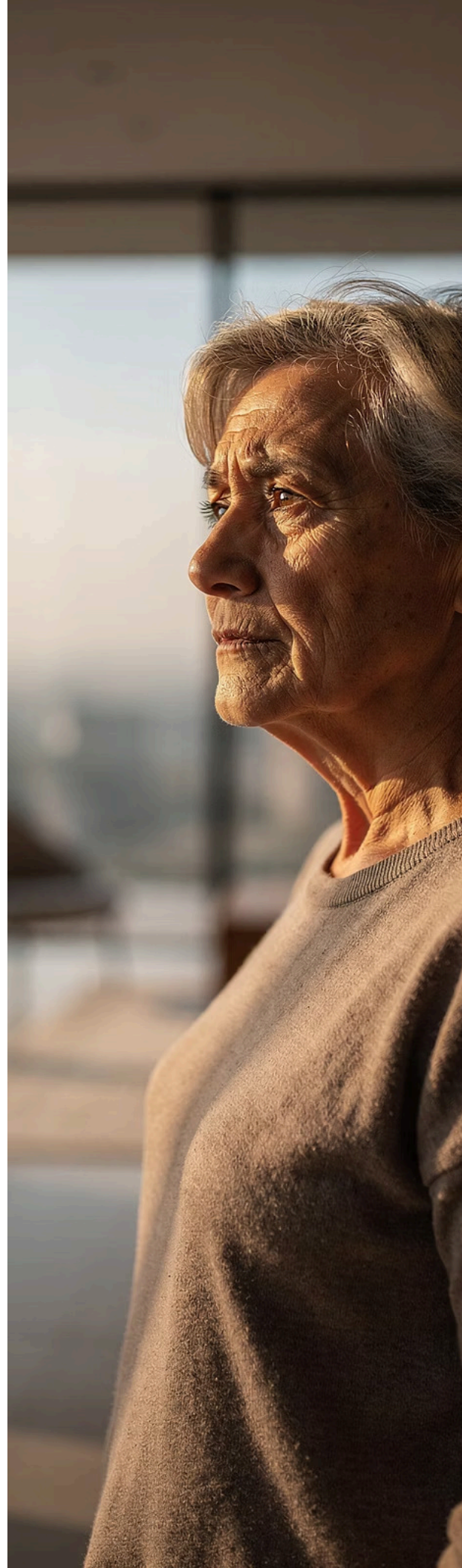

With the decision made, the new home chosen, and the sorting complete, the actual logistics of moving come into focus. Most downsizing moves benefit from a minimum 60-day runway between contract signing and moving day.

Get at least three written quotes and verify each company's licensing, insurance, and reviews before booking.



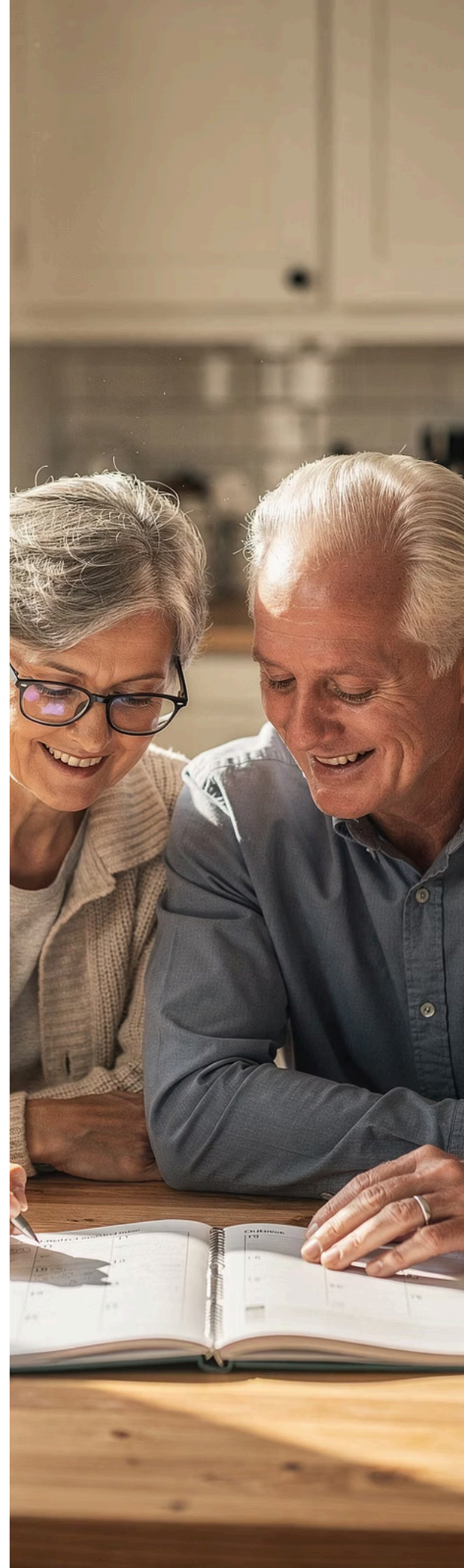
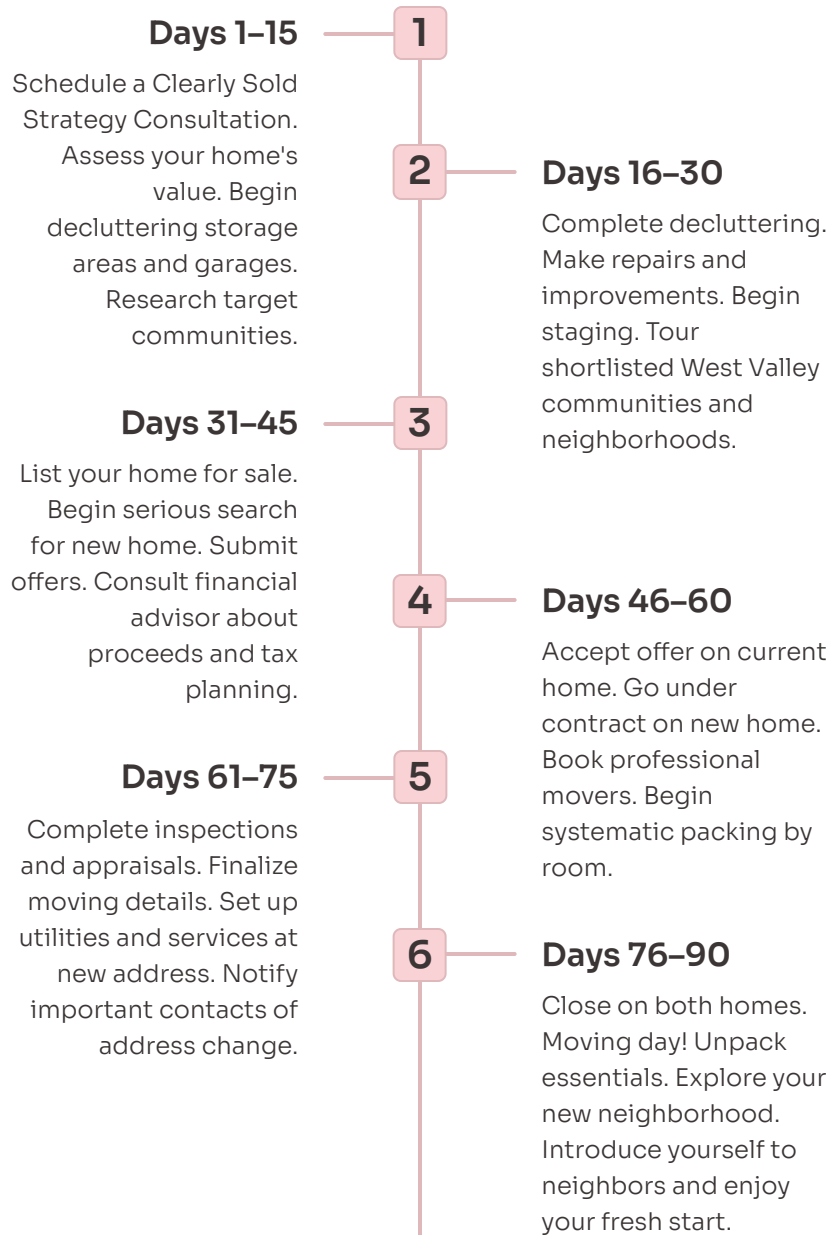
Create a dedicated "moving essentials" box — packed last, opened first. Include medications, important documents, phone chargers, a change of clothes, toiletries, snacks, and anything you'll need immediate access to on moving day and the first night in your new home. This simple step eliminates one of the most common moving-day frustrations.

- ❑ Arizona-specific tip: Schedule your move for the early morning hours. Phoenix summer temperatures can reach extreme highs by 10 a.m. — early morning moves are safer, more comfortable, and movers work more efficiently in cooler conditions. October through April moves can be timed more flexibly.
