Paperwork and Government

I wanted to take a moment to share an important update on our visa process for North Macedonia. As many of you know, this is a key step that allows us to live and serve long-term in the Balkans.

We recently heard back from the immigration office, and unfortunately, our residency visa application was denied. Thankfully, the reasons are minor and easily fixable. The first issue was that my passport was six days short of the required 15-month validity period. The second was that our health insurance policy did not extend far enough into the coming year.

Both of these issues are already being resolved. I've received my new passport, and we are in the process of extending our insurance coverage to meet the full requirement. Once that is complete, we'll resubmit our application for approval.

At this time, we are planning to fly over on November 10th, but we're watching the situation carefully and trusting the Lord to guide our timing. Through each step, He continues to remind us that His plans are always right on schedule.

Please continue to pray for:

- Favor and a smooth process as we resubmit our visa paperwork.
- Provision and strength as we prepare for travel.
- God's perfect timing in our upcoming move and ministry ahead.

Thank you for standing with us through your prayers, encouragement, and financial support. Your faithfulness is helping us take the gospel to the people of Macedonia and throughout the Balkans.
