Starting immediately, you and every other party are restrained from removing from the state, or applying for a passport for, the minor child or children for whom this action seeks to establish a parent-child relationship or a custody order without the prior written consent of every other party or an order of the court.

CHILD CUSTODY AND PARENTING TIME (VISITATION) - custody with allegations of a history of abuse or substance abuse.

1. Respondent and I met in 2015. In the summer of 2016, while I was pregnant with our twins, Respondent was deported to Mexico (see item below). I was kidnapped by Respondent's mother and taken from our home in Los Angeles, CA, to Mexico against my will. Specifically, Respondent's mother told me that we were going out to get food, but instead she drove me and all three of my daughters (including my eldest who is a child from a different relationship) across the border into Mexico. I only realized what was happening when we reached the border and saw the signs. I did not want to go to Mexico, but I did not have control over the situation. Once we arrived in Puebla, Mexico, I was isolated from my family and support system.
2. Upon my arrival in Puebla, Respondent's mother told me that Respondent had been married before and was arrested in CA after attempting to stab his wife. Sometime in early 2016, Respondent was found guilty of domestic violence against his wife and was given the option of going jail or deportation; Respondent chose deportation at a time when our twins were not even born yet and that's when Respondent's mother kidnapped me and all of my children and took us to Mexico (see item #1, above). Learning about this history increased my fear of reporting Respondent's behavior to law enforcement.
3. Throughout my relationship with Respondent, he regularly used physical discipline that caused injury or fear. For example, he would strike and our children, including during my pregnancy. He also locked us in a room within our home and left us there when he went out, which prevented us from seeking help or leaving the residence. Had there been a fire or some other natural disaster, we could have easily died. Respondent also drank alcohol frequently and used cocaine throughout the relationship, which made his behavior more unpredictable and increased the risk of harm to me and the children.
4. In the winter of 2016, Respondent attacked my oldest child from another relationship and hit her. I was able to send my oldest daughter back to the United States to live with my mother but my daughter has been in therapy for trauma symptoms ever since. I believe that witnessing Respondent's violence has similarly impacted our twins.
5. In May of 2017, when our daughter Arleth was about 15 months old, she was crying because she did not want to eat. Respondent became angry, grabbed her and threw her against a wall. Arleth hit the back of her head and developed a purple bump. I had no support or access to resources since we were living in Puebla, Mexico. I did not report the incident to the Mexican police because I was afraid of Respondent and could not feel safe seeking help.
6. After our youngest child was born in 2018, Respondent took all of the children's birth certificates, social security cards and passports. Respondent and Respondent's grandmother took us to his grandmother's house, locked us in a room and kept us isolated and with very little food for almost one (1) month. Respondent wanted me to sign documents saying I would never ask him for financial support for our children but I refused. Sometime around March 2018, I was able to escape with our children, took a bus and I went to be with my family in a different region of Mexico (Ayutla, Jalisco). I stayed hidden with my family there until October 2023 when I returned to the United States with our children.
6. Sometime in 2019, Respondent contacted me by phone and Facebook and stated that if I did not do what he wanted, he would take our daughters and hurt them. He threatened to kill them and specifically stated that he would use a knife. He also threatened to harm my family. These threats occurred over the phone and through Facebook messages. After making these threats, Respondent accessed my Facebook account without my permission and deleted the messages. As a result, I no longer have copies of those written threats. I was afraid for my daughters' safety, and I continue to fear that Respondent will act on these threats.
