Reflection

This week reflection on Paul and Titus.

Paul and Titus

Titus, like Timothy, came to be ministering with Paul among the Gentiles. Titus is from Crete in the Mediterranean Ocean. Paul was familiar with the areas that Timothy and Titus came from, through his travels around the world, and also because Paul was from Tarsus which is on the other side of the Mediterranean from the Holy Land, towards Spain. Paul calls Titus a fellow worker in the faith. Like Timothy, he is Greek and also became a bishop for the Gentile people and also for the Jewish converts.

Paul says that Titus did not have to be circumcised, which shows the difference of preaching among the Gentiles. The Gentiles are brought into the covenant in Jesus Christ through their hearts by faith and through baptism. They receive the Holy Spirit just like the apostles did at Pentecost, and this is the sign that they are part of the same body with Jewish converts in the one Body of Jesus Christ.

Titus shows us how fruitful the ministry of Paul was. There were many converts to Christianity by the power of the Holy Spirit. In Crete, there were so many Christians that there had to be a bishop placed there out in the Mediterranean to take care of all the Jewish and Gentile converts, to keep peace and to appoint priests to take care of all the faithful. This is the responsibility that Paul gave to Titus, and Titus shares the ministry with Paul by staying in Crete and keeping the Church united to Paul and the other apostles to be united to Jesus Christ.

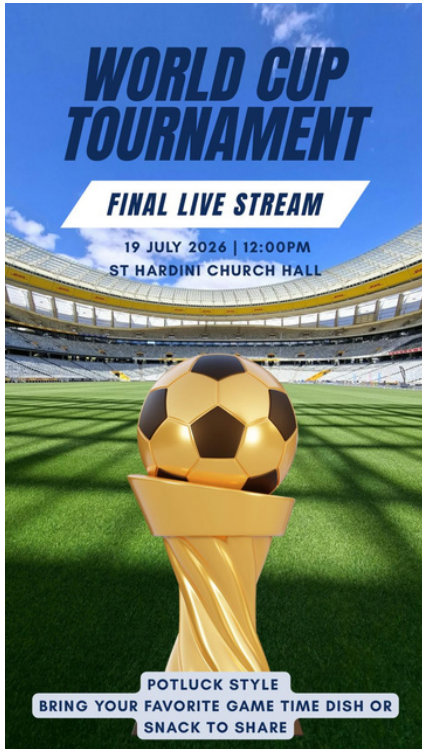
