GUEST SAFETY & PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

ADVENTURE RESPONSIBLY.

Please review these requirements before participating in any Jungle Boy Tours experience. Every guest is expected to follow activity-day instructions, use required safety equipment correctly, and communicate any concern that may affect safe participation.

10 SERVICES COVERED

Land, ocean, nighttime and transportation experiences.

GUEST RESPONSIBILITY

Prepare properly, listen carefully and follow instructions.

CONDITIONS MATTER

Weather, water, trails and visibility can change the plan.

Important: These requirements are general safety guidance and do not replace instructions, eligibility rules or equipment requirements given by the responsible guide, captain, driver or activity operator. Activity-day instructions take priority.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

These requirements apply broadly across Jungle Boy Tours experiences. Individual operators may add age, size, health, equipment or participation requirements for a specific activity.

01 Follow Instructions

Listen to the guide, captain, driver or operator before and during the activity. Ask questions if anything is unclear.

02 Use Safety Gear

Wear and use helmets, life jackets, harnesses, seat belts and other required equipment exactly as instructed.

03 Communicate Concerns

Tell the activity provider about relevant limitations, injuries, swimming concerns or other circumstances that may affect participation.

04 Stay With The Group

Remain inside designated areas and approved routes. Do not attempt unapproved swims, jumps, shortcuts or detours.

05 No Impaired Participation

Do not drive, ride, swim, operate equipment or participate in adventure activities while impaired.

06 Respect Conditions

Weather, surf, current, wind, river levels, trail conditions and visibility may require a change, delay or cancellation.

Jungle Boy Tours, guides and activity operators may modify, delay or stop an experience when conditions are not appropriate for safe participation.

General preparation checklist

- ☐ Wear activity-appropriate clothing and secure footwear.
- ☐ Stay hydrated, especially during longer outdoor or ocean activities.
- ☐ Confirm child participation requirements before the activity.
- ☐ Bring or use sun protection for extended outdoor exposure.
- ☐ Secure phones, jewelry and personal items that could fall or snag.
- ☐ Ask Jungle Boy Tours what to bring if you are unsure.

LAND & ADVENTURE REQUIREMENTS

Review the section that matches your activity. Additional requirements may be provided at check-in or by the responsible operator.

JUNGLE + TRAIL

01

ATV Tours

- Wear the helmet and any protective equipment required.
- Follow the guide's speed, spacing and route instructions.
- Do not race, perform stunts, jump or take unapproved shortcuts.
- Reduce speed on mud, loose gravel, water crossings and uneven terrain.
- Wear secure footwear and clothing suitable for trail riding.
- Never operate an ATV while impaired.

BEACH + JUNGLE

02

Horseback Riding

- Follow all mounting, riding and dismounting instructions.
- Wear secure footwear and suitable riding clothing.
- Maintain the spacing and pace instructed by the guide.
- Do not crowd, strike or intentionally startle another horse.
- Remain on the approved route.
- Remember that horses can react unexpectedly.

OCEAN ACTIVITY

03

Surf Lessons

- Tell the instructor your swimming and surfing experience level.
- Enter and exit the water only where directed.
- Keep a safe distance from other surfers, swimmers and boards.
- Use the board leash and required equipment as instructed.
- Do not paddle into conditions the instructor tells you to avoid.
- Respect changing waves, currents and tides.

CANOPY ADVENTURE

04

Canopy & Zipline

- Wear the harness, helmet and required gear exactly as instructed.
- Do not disconnect, loosen or alter safety equipment.
- Follow braking, hand-position and platform instructions.
- Wait for the operator's signal before starting each line.
- Secure loose items and long hair.
- Follow the operator's age, size, weight and participation restrictions.

For ATV, horseback and zipline activities, the responsible operator may have specific age, height, weight, footwear or other eligibility rules. Confirm these requirements before arrival.

OCEAN & WATER REQUIREMENTS

Ocean, weather and water conditions can change quickly. Follow the current instructions given by the guide, captain or activity operator.

PACIFIC OCEAN

05

Sport Fishing

- Follow the captain and crew's instructions at all times.
- Use life jackets or flotation equipment when required.
- Move carefully on wet or moving decks and use available handholds.
- Keep clear of active hooks, lines, rods and fishing equipment.
- Use sun protection and stay hydrated offshore.
- Ocean conditions may change routes or departure plans.

WATER ACTIVITY

06

Snorkeling

- Tell the guide your swimming ability before entering the water.
- Use flotation equipment when required or recommended.
- Stay inside the designated snorkeling area and with the group.
- Do not touch, chase, feed or remove marine wildlife.
- Enter and exit the water only where instructed.
- Currents, waves and visibility may change during the experience.

ISLAND + BOAT

07

Tortuga Island

- Follow crew instructions when boarding, riding and leaving the boat.
- Use life jackets or flotation equipment when required.
- Stay in approved swimming and snorkeling areas.
- Use caution on wet surfaces, docks, rocks and beach access points.
- Use sun protection and stay hydrated during the full-day experience.
- Boat routes and water activities may change with ocean conditions.

PADDLE ADVENTURE

08

Kayak Tours

- Wear a life jacket when required by the operator.
- Tell the guide your swimming and paddling experience level.
- Stay with the group and inside the approved route.
- Follow instructions for launching, landing and handling a capsized.
- Keep distance from rocks, boats and other hazards.
- Wind, current and weather may require route changes.

NIGHT & TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS

Low-light and road travel require extra attention. Follow all current instructions and remain aware of your surroundings.

NIGHT WATER EXPERIENCE

Bioluminescence

09

- Follow all nighttime movement and water-entry instructions.
- Use life jackets or other safety equipment when required.
- Stay with the group and do not move into unapproved areas.
- Use extra care around docks, shorelines and boats in low visibility.
- Avoid unnecessary bright lights when instructed by the guide.
- Weather, visibility and water conditions may change the tour plan.

PRIVATE TRAVEL

Private Transportation

10

- Wear seat belts whenever available and required.
- Remain seated while the vehicle is moving.
- Keep aisles and exits clear of luggage and loose items.
- Wait for the driver before loading, unloading or crossing near traffic.
- Use appropriate child restraints when applicable.
- Follow driver instructions during roadside stops and route changes.

When conditions change

A Weather

Rain, lightning, heat, visibility and other conditions may affect an activity.

B Ocean

Surf, wind, currents and boat conditions may change routes or water access.

C Trails & Rivers

Mud, river levels, debris or terrain may require a different route or cancellation.

D Operator Decision

The responsible provider may delay, modify or stop participation when conditions are not appropriate.
