Most people visualize marketing as a straight line: **Business** → **Content** → **Audience** → **Sale**. But Corporate America, Hollywood, and Main Street don't operate that way. The Hollywood Layer

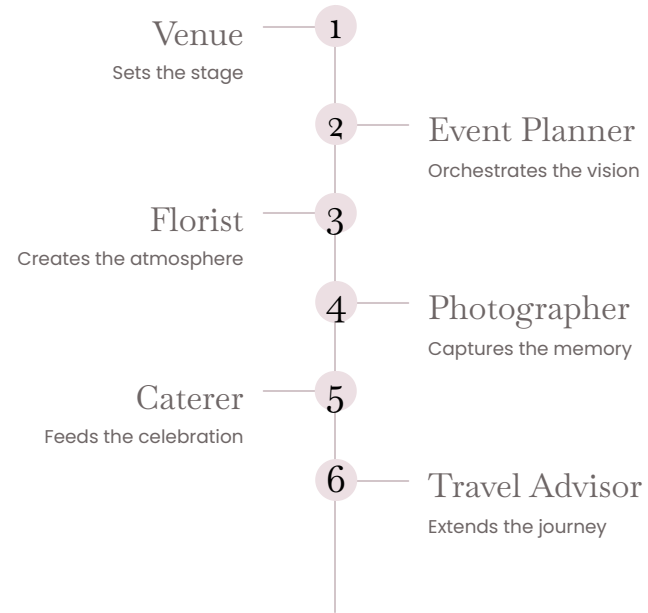

The Main Street Layer

Main Street introduces **customer journey clustering**. Think about a woman planning a wedding — she needs multiple businesses, each serving the same buyer at different stages. Instead of competing, they continuously exchange opportunities. **The customer stays inside the ecosystem.**



When You Combine All Three

This is what collaborative architecture *actually* looks like. Not one business. Not one audience. Not one promotional channel. An **interconnected ecosystem** where every node strengthens every other node.

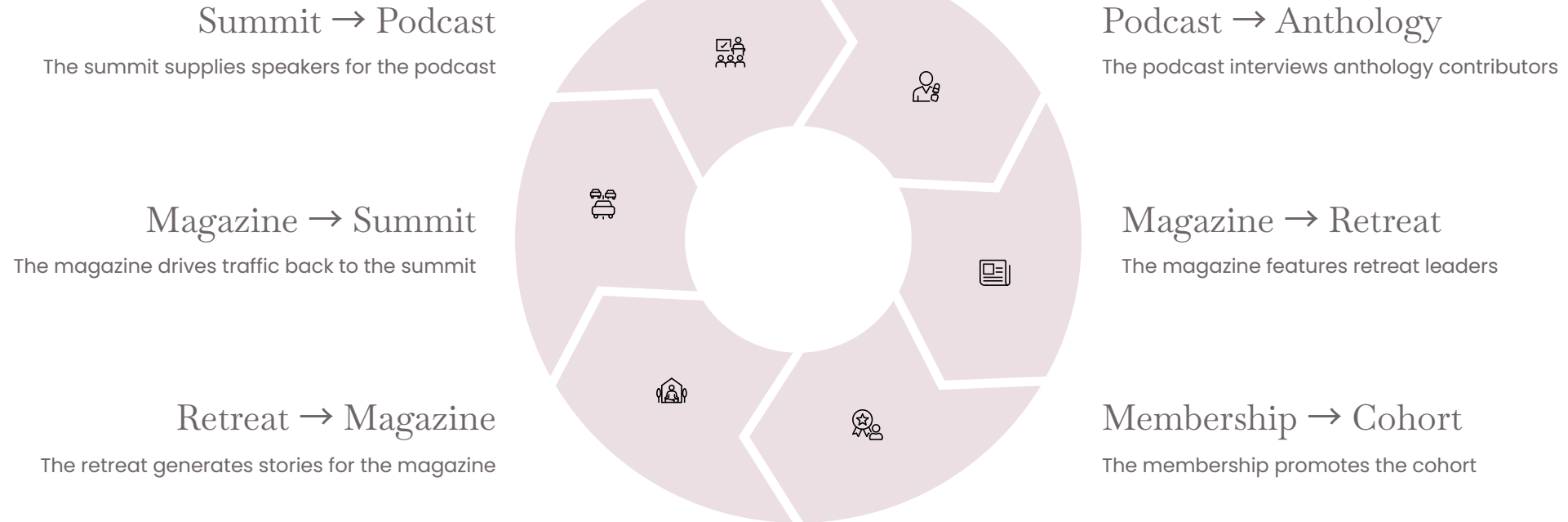

The Ecosystem in Motion
