



Prayer Points 1-11 were provided by Moshe, a Jewish-Israeli-Canadian, on one of our Daily Prayer Calls last week:

1. Pray that people would awaken to the political realities in Canada (and in other nations) that are eroding fundamental Western values. Many are unaware (or have “fallen asleep”) to this reality.
2. Pray for faith leaders to stop being apolitical and/or silent regarding Israel.
3. Pray against antisemitism. Per capita, Toronto has the highest incidents of antisemitism globally.
4. The US-Iran war will most likely resume, and continued prayer is needed to see a decisive victory against the Iranian Regime and for the war objectives to be accomplished. Pray that America will not stop the war prematurely.
5. Pray for allied nations to step up to help open the Strait of Hormuz, as 20% of the world’s oil flows through there.
6. Pray for wisdom for American and Israeli leaders regarding the war.
7. Pray for the upcoming Israeli elections, which may be held in August or September.
8. Pray for the upcoming American elections (midterms), which will be held in November.
9. Pray for Israel’s ministries, many of whom are facing financial strain.
10. Pray for the Iranians as they remain in a state of tension over whether the war will resume.
11. There is a lot at stake at this time. Pray that all people of faith would be activated and mobilized, not only to pray but also to support, champion, and vote.
12. Pray for both the National Leadership Center, located in Ariel, Israel, and the Jerusalem Leadership Institute. Pray blessings on all the staff, including Eran Glazer, Rachely Scapa, Tair, and the rest of the team and their families. Pray for the anointing and the financial provision for both facilities (Proverbs 10:22).
13. Continue to pray for hidden evil to be revealed and brought down, for lies to be exposed, and for truth to prevail. May evil never succeed. Pray that lies in reporting, whether legacy media or social media, would also be exposed and removed. (Psalms 51:6).
14. Pray for healing for the traumatized, for those grieving, and for families under great stress in Israel (Exodus 15:26).
15. Pray for a great spiritual awakening in Israel with hearts turning to the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Ezekiel 36:26).
16. Pray specifically for the IDF soldiers who are known to our community, especially as there is now a ground operation in Lebanon and ongoing conflict in Gaza. Pray for the son-in-law of Dean Bye (of the Aliyah Return Center): Chaim Malespin. Pray for those related to Arie Bar David and his daughter Ayelet (of Yad Hashmona): Achinoam and Oriyah, Eden and Tal, Yonatan, Tsurayah, Annael, Tsuriel, Bat-Ami, and Gideon. Pray for Meir, Zev, and Randy (the brothers of Moshe from Canada), and Shuki and Emma Aaron (son and daughter of Joshua Aaron). Pray for those related to Ari Sacher: Elyasaf, Amichai, Tiara, and Assaf. Pray for Ariel Ben-har, Deborah, Shaked Tzemach, Elijah Reyes, and Abigail Reyes. Pray for Eitan Wiseman, son of Mordechai Wiseman (Israel Firstfruits), as well as brothers Joel and Mati Jelski. While Eran’s sons are not engaged in the IDF right now, keep praying for them: Yonatan and Itamar (Psalms 91).
