



1. At the time of this writing, another ceasefire is in place after Iran attacked Israel earlier in the week. President Trump says victory will be declared over Iran in two weeks. However, many are concerned that there has been no change in Iranian leadership, which means that the regime's agendas remain intact (including the motivation to sponsor terror, declare death to Israel and America, and all the other issues with Iran's leadership— other than the removal of a nuclear threat). Pray for wisdom for President Trump. Pray against wrong advisors and spiritual forces that might bring confusion. Pray for a true victory over this regime and the strengthening of lasting peace in the Middle East ([Psalm 28:3](#)).
2. Israel recently struck Dahiya, a suburb of Beirut, because, for decades, it has operated as Hezbollah's political, operational, and military center. Hezbollah's drones and rockets that were launched during a supposed ceasefire have killed at least 11 IDF soldiers and sent many Israelis from the north into bomb shelters. Please pray for the defeat of Hezbollah in Lebanon and peace in the north of Israel ([Isaiah 54:17](#)).
3. Pray for both the [National Leadership Center](#), located in Ariel, Israel, and the [Jerusalem Leadership Institute](#). Pray blessings on all the staff, including Eran Glazer, Rachely Scapa, Tair, and the rest of the team and their families. Pray for the anointing and the financial provision for both facilities. There are students and IDF soldiers at the NLC this week ([Proverbs 10:22](#)).
4. Each week, we pray against antisemitism worldwide. This remains an important prayer point. One specific way to pray is to petition the Lord to raise up righteous leaders on university campuses, in colleges, and across all educational institutions. May proper, truthful education be taught regarding Israel and the Jewish people, and may lies be torn down. May antisemitic social media posts be rejected. May all spheres of society stand for biblical values, and may silence regarding antisemitism no longer be tolerated ([Psalm 10:17-18](#)).
5. On the Gaza front, more evidence of terror links in aid groups has been exposed. Hamas continues to rebuild its terror network under a ceasefire. Pray for Hamas to be soundly defeated in its ability to control Gaza ([Ezra 5:8](#)).
6. Pray for peace in Judea and Samaria as well as for Israel to declare and enforce sovereignty in this heartland of Israel ([Genesis 26:3](#)).
7. Pray that ships could move freely through the Strait of Hormuz without fear of mines or Iranian exploitation ([Psalm 24:2](#)).
8. Pray for the upcoming Israeli elections (which may be held in August or September) and for the US midterm elections (to be held in November). May the Lord's perfect will be done ([Psalm 107:42](#)).
9. Continue to pray for hidden evil to be revealed and brought down, for lies to be exposed, and for truth to prevail. May evil never succeed. Pray that lies in reporting, whether legacy media or social media, would also be exposed and removed. ([Psalm 51:6](#)).
10. Pray for healing for the traumatized, for those grieving, and for families under great stress in Israel. Marriages are under tremendous pressure, and finances are a problem for many ([Exodus 15:26](#)).
11. Pray for a great spiritual awakening in Israel with hearts turning to the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob ([Ezekiel 36:26](#)).
12. Pray specifically for the IDF soldiers who are known to our community, especially as there is now a ground operation in Lebanon and ongoing conflict in Gaza. Pray for the son-in-law of Dean Bye (of the Aliyah Return Center): Chaim Malespin. Pray for those related to Arie Bar David and his daughter Ayelet (of Yad Hashmona): Achinoam and Oriyah, Eden and Tal, Yonatan, Tsuriyah, Annael, Tsurriel, Bat-Ami, and Gideon. Pray for Meir, Zev, and Randy (the brothers of Moshe from Canada), and Shuki and Emma Aaron (son and daughter of Joshua Aaron). Pray for those related to Ari Sacher: Elyasaf, Amichai, Tiara, and Assaf. Pray for Ariel Ben-har, Deborah, Shaked Tzemach, Elijah Reyes, and Abigail Reyes. Pray for Eitan Wiseman, son of Mordechai Wiseman (Israel Firstfruits), as well as brothers Joel and Mati Jelski. While Eran's sons are not engaged in the IDF right now, keep praying for them: Yonatan and Itamar ([Psalm 91](#)).
