The Brantley County Board of Commissioners held a work session on October 7, 2025, 6:00 PM, in the Commission Office.

Present were Chairman, Chris Harris, Board Members Hal Herndon, Brian Hendrix, Andy Riggins and Randy Davison. County Manager, Joey Cason and County Attorney, Steven Blackerby.

Chairman Harris called the meeting to order; gave the invocation and led in the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Commissioner Hendrix made a motion to accept the September 2025 Minutes. Commissioner Riggins seconded the motion. All in favor motion carried.

The County Manager made a recommendation to amend the agenda to add the following item:

Consideration of Proclamation- Retired Educators Day

**AGENDA**

1. Consideration of quotes for SCBA equipment- Hoboken VFD

The County Manager stated three quotes were received and he recommended going with Ten8 so equipment is consistent with all other fire departments' gear. Commissioner Riggins made a motion to purchase the SCBA equipment from Ten8 for the amount of \$77,235.25 to be paid out of Hoboken fire account. Commissioner Herndon seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

2. Consideration of quotes for painting- Office Complex Building

The County Manager stated that 3 quotes were received, and he recommended going with lowest bid from Heritage Pro Coatings. Commissioner Davison made the motion to accept the bid from Heritage Pro Coating for \$9,500.00 to be paid out of Capital Projects. Commissioner Hendrix seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

3. Consideration of quotes for brush mower- Road Department

The County Manager recommended going with the AgPro 15" Rhino for mowing the Airport. Commissioner Riggins made a motion to purchase the Rhino Brush Mower from AgPro for \$22,650.00 to be paid from 2025 SPLOST. Commissioner Herndon seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

4. Consideration of Lease Renewal- DFCS

Commissioner Hendrix made a motion to renew the lease with the State Properties Commission for the Brantley County DFCS building for the amount of \$10,710 monthly, for a total of \$128,520 per year. Commissioner Davison seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

5. Consideration of declaring surplus items

The County Manager stated that the attached list of items is to be declared surplus. He also stated that the Sheriff's office will be adding items to this list as well. Commissioner Hendrix made a motion

to adopt these items as surplus. Commissioner Hendrix seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

5A. Consideration of the Southern GA Regional Commission 5311 transit grant- resolution

The County manager stated this resolution will allow the Southern GA regional Commission to submit the annual 5311 Transit Grant on behalf of Brantley County. Commissioner Hendrix made the motion to adopt the resolution for the 5311 Transit Grant application. Commissioner Riggins seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Chairman Harris called the meeting to order; Commissioner Riggins gave the invocation.

Commissioner Hendrix made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Herndon seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

The County Manager advised the purpose of this meeting is to set the proposed millage rate in the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Brantley County

The County Clerk has list of motions and resolutions that need to be adopted.

Commissioner Hendrix made a motion to set the proposed county-wide gross millage in the unincorporated area at 18.5303 mills, less 3.5622 mills for the insurance premium tax rollback, less 3.2813 mills for the local options sales tax rollback for a net M & 0 millage for unincorporated Brantley County at 11.6868 mills. Commissioner Riggins seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Herndon made a motion to set the proposed gross millage in the incorporated area at 18.5303 mills, less 3.2813 mills for the local option sales tax rollback for a net M & 0 Millage of 15.2490. (excludes insurance premium tax rollback which city receives directly.) Commissioner Hendrix seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Riggins made a motion to set the proposed millage in each special tax district at 1.25 mills. Commissioner Hendrix seconded the motion. Motion carried.
