




AR/VR STEM Education Lab

Short-Term Milestones (6-12 Months)

- Expand STEM programming to 10 new school districts (2025).
- Achieve a 15% increase in online digital fundraising.
- Launch the national Esports scholarship fund (Q3 2025).

Long-Term Impact (1-5 Years)

- Guide 60% of high school participants into STEM education or careers post-graduation.
- Secure \$2M in corporate STEM sponsorships by 2027.
- Improve participant emotional intelligence and graduation rates by 30%.





The Four-Phase Roadmap from Foundation to National Scale




STEM & Innovation

Proficiency gains, competition participation rates, and student retention.




Esports & Careers
