FIRE SAFETY

- ☐ Smoke alarms are installed and working.
- ☐ I know the sound of the smoke alarm.
- ☐ I know two ways out of each room.
- ☐ We have a family fire escape plan.
- ☐ I know our outside meeting place.

Look around.

Listen to grown-ups
and follow rules.



Speak up if
something doesn't
seem safe.



Stay with a friend
or a grown-up.



HOME HAZARDS

- ☐ Cords and wires are out of walkways.
- ☐ Stairs and floors are clear.
- ☐ Cleaning products are stored safely.
- ☐ Sharp objects (knives, tools, scissors) are put away.
- ☐ Heavy items are stored on lower shelves.



KITCHEN SAFETY

- ☐ I always ask a grown-up before using the stove or oven.
- ☐ Pot handles are turned inward on the stove.
- ☐ I keep flammable items away from the stove.
- ☐ I know not to touch hot surfaces.



PERSONAL SAFETY

- ☐ I know my full name, address and phone number.
- ☐ I know not to open the door for strangers.
- ☐ I know who my safe adults are.
- ☐ I ask before going anywhere.



OUTDOOR SAFETY

- ☐ I wear a helmet when riding my bike or scooter.
- ☐ I stay away from busy streets and construction areas.
- ☐ I know never to play with matches or lighters.
- ☐ I check with a grown-up before going outside.
