Greetings OCBC! Wow, it sure is wonderful to see the current lake level and know more water was roaring into the lake as of yesterday evening. Good news is even more rain is expected.

As I write this, I am preparing for our second Town Hall discussion on a potential dues increase. We had a great turnout for the first session and anticipate the second meeting will be the same. The Board came to the first Town Hall with a proposal to increase Regular Member dues from \$1,000 to \$1,200, Initiation dues to remain at \$1,000, other member categories to stay at the same fractional levels of Regular Member dues as identified in the Bylaws. After great feedback from participants, a consensus was reached to raise Regular Member dues to \$1,200 with \$1,000 of the individual dues going to the operating account and \$200 going to the restricted aka capital account; increase the Initiation fee to \$1,200 with the total going to the restricted aka capital account; all other member categories to stay at the same fractional levels of Regular Member dues as identified in the Bylaws; and a membership dues schedule to be created, which will be placed in a yet-to-be-determined location in print and on the website. We look forward to even more feedback from tonight's meeting and finalization of the proposal to be announced at the July Member Meeting on Thursday, July 13. We do need a quorum for the July 13 meeting as we have lots of membership-related business to conduct.

Lots of other things are going on in the coming days. Hmmmmmmmfest and Captain Morgan on Saturday July 15 and our weekly centerboard, keelboat and Sunday Series racing. I look forward to seeing you all around the club and on the water.

# Own a Centerboard, Multi hull? You Need to be at Hmmmmmmfest 2023

A former CSSA Affiliated Regatta

Now Hosted by Oklahoma City Boat Club

Saturday July 15, 2023 Lake Hefner, Oklahoma City

1. RULES: This regatta will be governed by the ‘rules’ as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS), except as any of these is altered by the Sailing Instructions. This changes RRS 63.7. OCBC Sailing Instructions will be used for this event with the following changes: SI 14 is changed to 10 minutes for the first leg and 40 minutes for the race.
2. ELIGIBILITY: (1) Participation is open to any member in good standing of any sailing organization. (2) All boats are required to comply with Lake Hefner registration laws, including carrying all required safety equipment.
3. FLEETS AND SCORING: Three boats of a type make a fleet; all others will race in a Portsmouth Yardstick (handicap) Fleet.
4. FEES: NONE

Seven short course fleet races

- A *very* short wait between starts (three minute countdown)
- Lunch available for a fee or bring your own
- Trophies one deep per fleet (three boats make a fleet)
- Multiple launch ramps, power wash, courtesy dock, beach
- A nice selection of vintage soft drinks, water, tea, and lemonade

Warning Signal	10:00 Race 1, followed by race 2 & 3

Race 4,5, Race 6 & 7: time and weather permitting. One race constitutes a regatta. Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the 30-minute protest filing deadline after the committee boat docks following the last race.


Ahoy all y'all,
