

## 2014 OCBC SAILING SEASON CURTAILED BY DEARTH OF WATER

This year our racing series, though short and sweet while water resources were available, started late and ended early:



By now, most boats are in, or are *en route* to, their dry slips, but a few remain in their harbor slips and some of those likely may remain there, stuck in the mud, until next spring.



Some OCBC club members are of the opinion that when the water level is down, there is an opportunity to explore options for dredging our harbor. Estimates are that dredging may extend our racing season up to two months.

The limited and unpredictable Lake Hefner water resources have precluded the Commodore Cup this year, and the Ida Lewis Championship in 2015. However, for those sailors willing to travel, check out the following page:

Six different fleet boats raced this season. We fleted in the July and August Wednesday Series, but unfortunately not in any of the regattas. Fleet first place finishes:



# The Fit and Healthy Sailor

**Hi to all my fellow sailors. I have been asked to contribute to the *Ye-Logge* with articles about fitness, safety, etc. Since that can be a fairly broad range of topics, if there is anything you'd like me to address, please let me know and I'll do my best. Since fitness is my favorite topic – I think we'll start there!**

While it may appear to be the “end of the season” around here, it's the right time to start on that fitness program you intended to start earlier in the summer. Cooler temps should help the motivation level a bit.

As expected, I must begin with – if you have any kind of medical condition – orthopedic (knee, back, ankle, etc.) or “illness” such as heart problems, lung, chronic illness, etc. – you should always discuss your situation with your physician before starting an exercise program! Make sure they're aware as the increase in exercise may affect use of medications, treatments, etc.

Where do we begin?!? Aerobic conditioning!! Aerobic exercise is anything that you can do for a specific length of time (20 minutes or so), it elevates your heart rate and you use a large muscle mass – typically your legs. This type of exercise works on the health of your heart, your lungs and your body's ability process/utilize oxygen. What are we talking about?!? Walking, biking, swimming, kayaking, etc. How does it help your sailing?!? It improves your endurance so you can sail longer or if you find yourself knocked off your boat and in the water, you'll have the endurance to swim back to the boat or to safety.



Here is the MOST important thing to remember, and it's my mantra when it comes to exercise programs. It needs to be *easy!* Yep, EASY! If it's not, and you try to do too much, you'll get sore and tired and you won't get up and do it the next day. So, no worries about boot camps or anything like that – not if you're just starting out. EASY! Realize you have a threshold – it's when you're getting really tired, your back hurts, your knee hurts, whatever it may be – your threshold. Exercise at a level that is just below that threshold. Do that 2-3 times per week – goal is to work up to a length of time of 30-45 minutes. Then... 1-2 times per week, challenge that threshold – move a little faster or work a little harder throughout the exercise session. Pick a tree and walk faster to that tree, then slow down and recover, then pick the next tree you'll walk faster to. Since you're working a little harder – you get to shorten the length of time – 15-20 minutes working up to 30 minutes.

We have this great trail right out our front door. Drive to the club with your bike or walking shoes and take off! (Just remember the code to get back through the gate!)

Final thing for today – “consistency is more important than volume or intensity”! I'd rather see you moving more consistently than working extremely hard.

Next month we'll discuss the second component of an exercise program that is extremely important to us as sailors – strength and balance!
