

# Rear Commodore's Report



What a great turn out for a last minute request for the Winter Weather Clean Up!!! I'm sure we had more but many thanks to those who signed up...David Newlon, Dereck Benda, George Davis, Deal Bowman, Gene McClendon, Ric Drennen, Alfonso Nieves, Mike Hahn, Duane Dahlgren, Jeff Stobbs, Bob Steele, Robbin Phillips, Terry Carlson, and Jay Collins. In just **2 hours** the entire club property was cleared and/or cleaned of branches and debris. I would also like to give a special thanks to David Newlon and Mike Hahn for taking it upon themselves to start the cleanup process on their own earlier in that week.

## Maintenance Items, Changes, and/or Improvements:

The new Dry and Wet slip maps are close to being done! Again, when finished they will be posted by the kegerator.

The MOUNTAIN of branches will be taken care of Sooner or later. We will see what the city says about it taking care of it and/or possibly mulching it ourselves.

The water has been turned back on feeding the dry slips and both hoists. The water to the youth shed has not been turned back on.

The west hoist is being worked on and will be back in operation soon.

The on/off switches for the air compressors (in the HD&A shed and the youth shed) AND for the lights in the sheds will be replaced with timer switches.

A dry erase will be mounted by the gate override switch located by the kegerator. This will be done to answer the eternal question...Why the heck is the gate open?!?!?

Other items are in the works. Keep your eye on the YeLogge for future maintenance items, changes and/or improvements to the boat club and facilities.

On a different note and a very important one. It has been brought to my attention that there seems to be more and more instances where there have been accidents, for lack of a better term, and the club where the members involved Do Not have insurance.

Section 1. Liability, Part B. of the Facilities Policy states:

*Members who are boat owners shall carry liability insurance applicable to sailing activities including racing, with a minimum combining limit for property damage and/or bodily injury of \$100,000. Any boat on Club grounds/property shall at all time be insured for liability insurance with a minimum limit of \$100,000 for property damage, bodily injury, or combined limit. **All members shall submit annually a copy of the Declaration Page of their homeowner's insurance or comparable document with the Member's dues submittal. Members with sail boats which are 26' or greater in overall length and/or power boats of 25hp or greater on the grounds shall maintain current proof of such coverage with the Rear Commodore or Facilities Chairman.***

There is a small number of you that have done so which obviously leaves a large number that Have Not. With that being said, I am asking the membership to submit a copy of their insurance declaration page. Delivery can be done by either a hard copy in the slot in the office door or an electronic copy emailed to me at [stan.nieves@gmail.com](mailto:stan.nieves@gmail.com).
