

Windycrest Invitational Regatta

Windycrest Sailing Club - Keystone Lake - Tulsa, Oklahoma

May 17-18, 2013

This is your invitation to sail in this CSSA Affiliated Regatta. It is open to all boats.

There will be no entry fee for this regatta.

Rules: Races will be governed by 2013-2016 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing as amended by US Sailing and Regatta Sailing Instructions. Category A event.

Safety: Standard safety equipment required by state law and class rules.

Scoring: Low point system- 1 pt for 1st, 2 pts for 2nd, etc. One throw out allowed if 7 or more races sailed.

Trophies: The Hobock-Tillotson Trophy will be awarded to the winning boat of a fleet that is selected as "*The most competitive fleet in the regatta*". The selection will be made by the PRO and other Race Committee members. Two trophies will be awarded per fleet.

Housing: Camping (primitive) & limited RV sites with electric at WSC.

Facilities: Open 2-story pavilion lakeside, modern bathhouse, three-wide ramp, ample parking.

Directions: From Tulsa, use US Hwy 412 West. Exit at 209th West Avenue. Turn right (North) on 209th and go 4.6 miles to

Windycrest Road. Turn left (West) on Windycrest Road and travel 1 mile to Windycrest.

Entry Fee: **There is no entry fee for this regatta.** While not required, all participants are encouraged to support your regional sailing association by joining the Central States Sailing Association. Membership information will be available at the registration desk.

Entry includes Continental breakfast on Saturday and Sunday plus soft drinks, beer, and snacks after the races.

Other fees: Saturday Evening Steak Cook Out- \$13.00. Advanced reservation required. Reservations can be made on the home page of www.windycrest.com and paid at regatta registration. Dinner will be "Cook Your Own Steak", along with baked potato, salad, dinner rolls, and iced tea.

Registration: There is no entry fee, but all participating boats must register prior to the competitors meeting. Boats not registered will not be scored.

Courses: A double windward/leeward course with a reaching mark will be utilized for all races. Our goal is to maximize the number, length, and enjoyment of races for all participants.
