



Garden Girls – Fairydust – fact sheet

What's in a name?

I first trialled Fairydust on a pair of pot-bound cumquats. Sad yellow leaves told their plight. Mixing a concentrated brew, I sloshed half a watering can onto each, doing the same a month later.

On our third visit, Joyce bailed me up. "What have you done to my cumquats?" The transformation was remarkable. On examining the black/gold powder, Joyce dubbed it Fairydust. A natural choice, as we were her 'Garden Fairies'. Dear Joyce is no longer with us, though gifted a legacy, for the name stuck. Why? Deep down we like a little magic.

Fairydust is a mix of Humic Acid, a small quantity of Fulvic Acid and three species of kelp in a concentrated freight- friendly soluble powder. Regular applications combined with mulching will promote healthier soil and plants. Fairydust dissolves easily and can be used as foliar spray or applied directly to roots.

Kelp

Kelp is recognized for growth promoting properties, its ability to improve plant stress-resistance and promoting the soil biome. Three varieties are used for virus protection, alginic acid (water retention) and high mineral content.

Humic Acid

Stabilizes nitrogen, is a natural chelating agent, buffering effects of mineral salts, toxic chemicals and heavy metals. Improves soil structure by promoting fungi to create a crumb structure for better water and oxygen intake.

Fulvic Acid

A finer molecule than humic acid, fulvic acid transports nutrients across the root membrane faster. Rehydrating plants quickly, electrolytes for plants. Supports microbes in the rhizosphere (soil around the roots) where microbes interact with the plant.

DIRECTIONS

- Dissolve thoroughly. Regular, mild applications are best.
- Suitable for any plant, including pot plants.
- Mild solutions can be applied as foliar spray.
- From $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ Teas per 10 Litres.
- 1 Teaspoon per Litre for concentrate, sprayed over root zone. Then hose in.
- Apply to stressed trees at rate of 2 Teas per Litre over entire root zone, water in well.
- Keep airtight, store away from light.
