### **Eligibility criteria**

- a. Nominees and nominators must be current IANAGH members.
- b. Must have contributed actively for a minimum of 1-2 years in the IANAGH.
- c. Demonstrate exemplary skills in the field where you are nominated for.
- d. One letter of recommendation (from any one of our Governing board members)
- e. A previous award recipient cannot be nominated for the same category.
- f. Governing board members are not eligible to apply for the award.
- g. Awards & Scholarship Committee members are not eligible to apply for the award.

### **Criteria for Nurse Excellence Awards:**

The nomination letter (self/others) should address the following criteria: Max 300 words

- a) Demonstrates excellence in professional practice through compassion, effective communication, and strong critical thinking skills to ensure optimal outcome.
- b) Actively contributed to IANAGH including notable contribution to community in the past two years.
- c) Implemented or contributed to evidence-based changes in nursing practice leading to improved patient care.
- d) Exhibits exemplary collaboration and serves as a role model for others.
- e) Demonstrates a steadfast commitment to enhancing patient outcomes and elevating the overall quality of care.
