## Dennis Brown Hall Phase 1 | \$100,000

Dennis Brown Hall, one of the original buildings on Heartland's campus, has served students faithfully for many years and is now in need of updates. Due to its age and continued use, certain areas of the building require renovation to ensure it remains functional.



## Parking Lot Resurfacing | \$50,000

Several of the campus parking lots have experienced significant wear over time. Cracks, uneven surfaces, and general deterioration have made resurfacing an important priority.



## Summer Operations | \$850,000

This funding allows Heartland to remain operational during the summer months without the need to secure a line of credit. Because students are not on campus during this time, the college experiences a temporary reduction in income. Despite this seasonal decrease, essential operations and ongoing expenses continue.

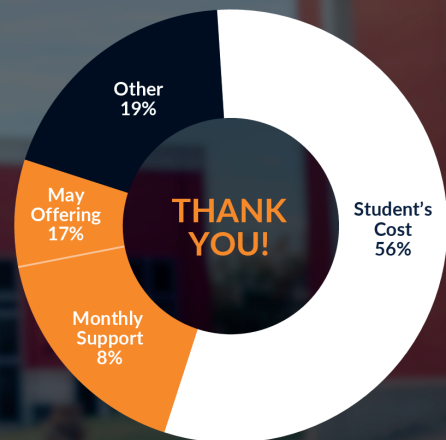
