Experience the West Coast



DAY 1: We welcome all our guests and depart at 09:00 from City Lodge GrandWest in Cape Town. We travel north and arrive in Vanrhynsdorp by late afternoon, where we stay at Namaqua Lodge.

DAY 2: After a delicious breakfast, we depart for the coastal town of Port Nolloth. We travel through the breathtaking Knersvlakte—known for its unique vegetation and vast, tranquil landscapes. By midday, we reach the ocean, where the fresh sea air and calm atmosphere instantly help you unwind. We overnight at the Scotia Inn Hotel with beautiful sea views.

DAY 3: After our first night by the sea, we follow the coastline south to Kleinsee. This remote area offers raw natural beauty and a true sense of escape. In the evening, we camp at Die Houthoop and enjoy a delicious seafood buffet under the open sky.

DAY 4: Adventure awaits! We climb into our 4x4 bus, *Trompie*, for an exciting shipwreck tour along the rugged and dramatic coastline—a powerful reminder of the ocean's history. We visit Hondeklip Bay and continue to Varswater in the Namaqua National Park, where we camp under a star-filled sky.

DAY 7: After breakfast, we travel to Lamberts Bay with a stop at Doringbaai's abalone farm, where we learn more about this unique industry. Later, a tour highlight awaits: an unforgettable seafood experience at Muisboskerm—famous for its fresh, traditional West Coast cuisine.

DAY 8: Today we take time to discover the unique character of the West Coast. We travel through charming coastal towns such as Elands Bay and Velddrif, where we also visit the well-known Bokkomlaan.

We continue to explore the peaceful shores of St Helena Bay and picturesque Paternoster, known for its whitewashed cottages and seaside charm. By late afternoon, we arrive in Port Owen, where we overnight along the river mouth.

Important to note

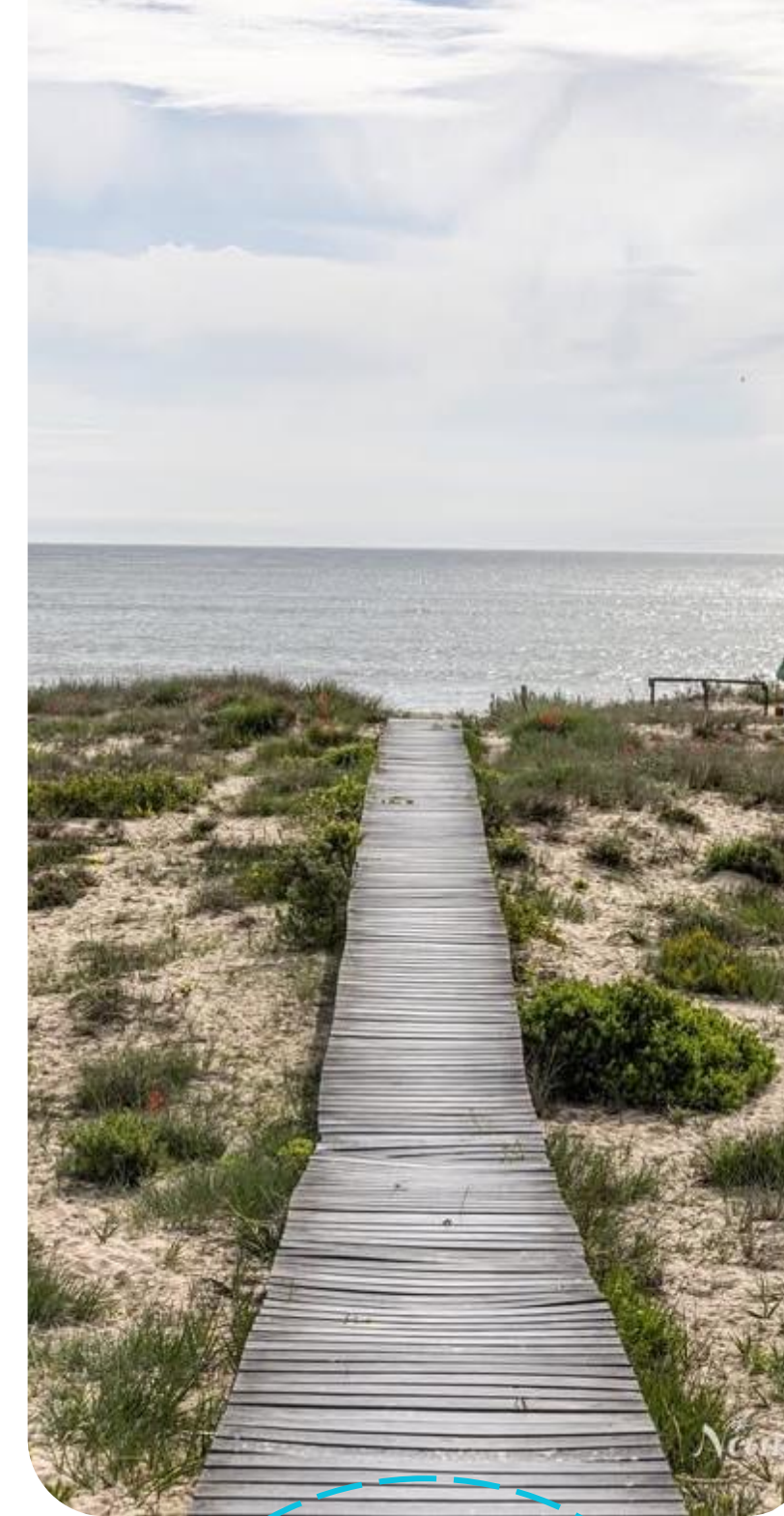

Single bookings can always be changed to a double/twin booking if you decide to bring a friend/partner along. A full refund will be made for the difference between sharing and single in case full payment has been received. No administrative fees will be charged.

When booking a flight from our end destination, please consult the office via email or phone to make sure that you do not book a flight (or other transport arrangements) too early.

We are happy to assist with flight bookings as well as payment of the flights – the cost is R250 per person for bank charges and administration fee. These flights will be booked after we have received your deposit. The cost of the flights, along with the R250 per person, is also payable immediately after the booking has been completed and you have received your flight ticket. Please note that we do not receive flights at a discounted rate, so you are welcome to book all flights yourself if you prefer.

At Namakwa Tours, we do our utmost to follow the tour itinerary as closely as possible. However, should unforeseen circumstances arise, we may adjust the program as needed. Our guests' best interests are always our top priority, and our goal is to provide them with an unforgettable holiday experience.





Road conditions and infrastructure

Roads in and throughout South Africa are often in poor condition, which makes it hard on our vehicles. We take great pride in our bus and ensure it is serviced regularly and is in a good condition, but breakdowns do happen. Some of the roads we travel on are long, full of dust and not exactly smooth sailing. This means that the travel time indicated is just a rough guide and dependant on various factors that are not always in our control. We know that it can be tough, but the destinations at the end of the day are extra-ordinary!



Medical & Health information

Travellers, old and young are required to be in good health to participate fully on this trip. We expect all travellers to read carefully through the program and asses you on the stress of activities mentioned in the day-to-day program. If in the opinion of our tour guide or leader, any traveller is unable to participate in activities or on the rest of the tour; they reserve the right to exclude them from the activity or tour at any stage, without refund. The appropriate documentation will be provided for travel insurance. All clients should consult their doctor or medical professional on information regarding vaccinations and anti-malaria medication requirements before departure. We recommend that you carry your own small first aid kit containing personal required medication and an extra pair of reading glasses. Rehydration salt, motion sickness tablets and diarrhoea blockers are also advisable to have on hand.



Drinking water

As a rule, we consider all tap water to be not suitable for human consumption, as it may contain different levels of minerals or bacteria than the water your stomach is used to at home. Your body may not be use to this, and it can cause illness. It will upset your stomach and it will spoil the rest of your trip. Many of the accommodation facilities we use provide guests with safe drinking water and bottled water is readily available throughout the trip. Please make sure to bring along a water bottle to fill up during the tour.
