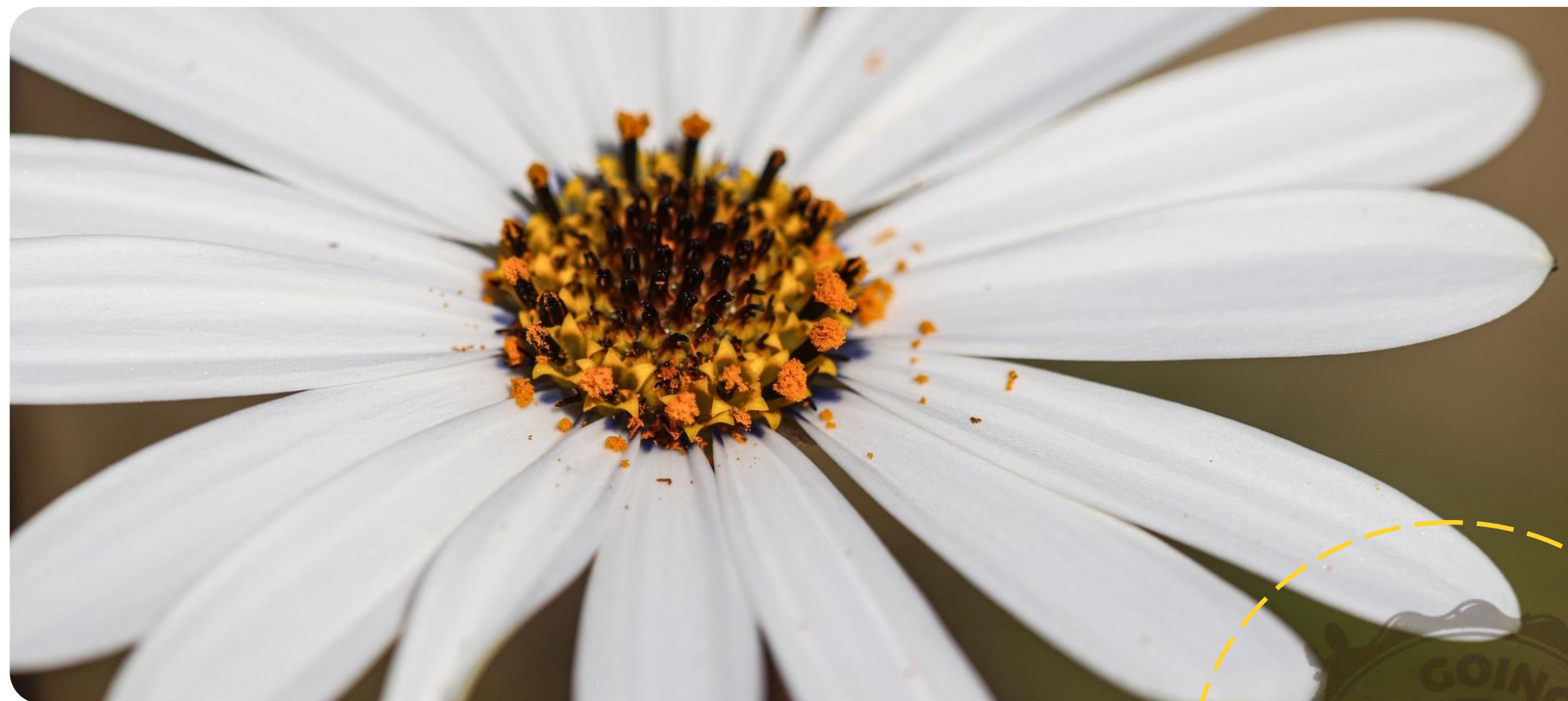

Please note that our flower season coincides with the rainy season. We reserve the right to adjust or change our daily itinerary according to weather conditions and the best flower displays.

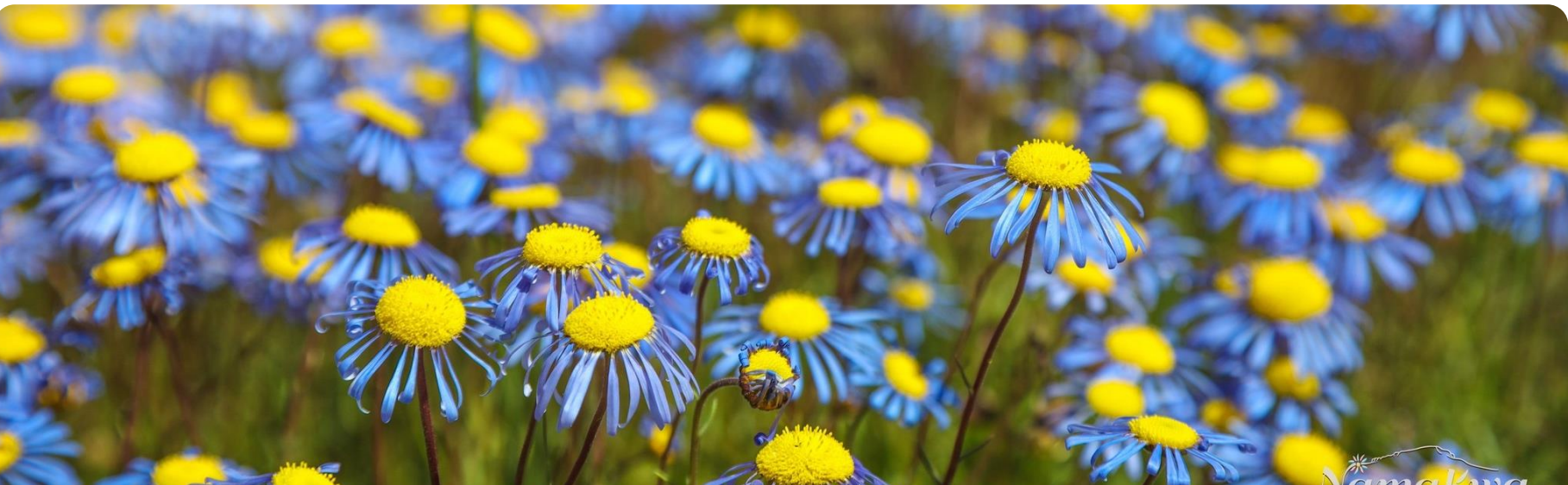

Important to know

Beyond Namaqualand's five main regions (Knersvlakte, Hardeveld, Namaqualand Rocky Hills, Richtersveld, and the Coastal Plain), there are several other areas that annually showcase some of the most spectacular flower displays, including the West Coast, Olifants River Valley, Swartland, Bokkeveld, Cederberg and the Biedouw Valley.

The flower region is vast, so be prepared to travel many kilometres with us in search of the best blooms.

Each region offers something unique and it is not possible to experience all areas at their peak at the same time.

Flower season is also the rainy season. On rainy days, flower viewing is not possible, which is why we remain based in one location for the duration of the tour – allowing us to adjust the programme according to the weather.

More than 3,500 different flower species grow in Namaqualand. Taking the time to learn about these plants adds far more value to your visit than simply viewing fields of flowers.

We can assist with flight bookings for your tour if you need to travel to Cape Town. Please note that an administration fee of R250 per person applies if we arrange flights on your behalf. Once flights have been booked, the full amount is payable into our bank account.

Hotel accommodation can also be arranged by us. We do not charge any commission on the rates provided by hotels. Shuttle services can be organised as well, with no additional administration fees.
