

My City/Town

This lesson is good for students who . . .

- **know town vocabulary**
- **can describe their town**
- **can talk about what they like to do in their town**
- **are curious about other towns and cities around the world**

Lesson Plan

- 1. Look at the pictures of famous places in London and Delhi. Talk about the pictures. Ask questions...**
 - **What do you see?**
 - **Is it noisy or quiet / old or modern?**
 - **Is there a (park/market) like this in our city?**
 - **What is a museum? What kind of museums are in our city?**
 - **Do you want to go there? Why? Why not?**
- 2. Find London and Delhi on a map. If your students are interested, you can look at more photos or videos of each city together.**
- 3. Share about the city where you grew up or a city you have visited.**
- 4. Ask your students what they like about their town or city. Hand out the first worksheet and have your students fill it out on their own, in small groups or as a class. Encourage your students to share all about their city.**



My City/Town

Make a Film!

- 1. Tell your students that they will make a film about their town or city for the EYE EXPO!**
- 2. Watch videos online of children sharing about their cities. Some good examples are ...**
 - KidsView - What to do in Sydney
 - Our student videos on InTogether.jp
- 3. Give your students the second worksheet and have them choose different places to share about in their film.**
- 4. Decide how you will make your video.**
 - Go to each location and film live footage
 - Take photos of each location and film in front of a green screen
 - Take photos and videos separately and make a video with a narrator.
 - etc.
- 5. Make a plan. Here are some things you will need to do. Decide who will do each task and when you will practice and record.**
 - Write the script for each place.
 - Practice the script.
 - Record & edit
 - Practice introducing the film and telling the audience who did what tasks.
 - Submit your video for the EYE EXPO Film Festival!
