Enrolment Terms & Conditions – 2026

1. Agreement

By submitting an enrolment form for Ellenbrook Ballet Academy (EBA), you acknowledge that you have read, understood and agree to these Terms & Conditions. This agreement takes effect immediately upon submission of the enrolment form.

2. Enrolment & Ongoing Membership

Enrolment at EBA is ongoing and continues week to week unless written notice of withdrawal is received in accordance with Section 6 below.

Formal withdrawal must be submitted in writing via email to: info@ellenbrookballet.com

Verbal, text or informal notifications are not accepted.

3. Fees, Billing & Payment

Weekly Direct Debit

- Tuition fees are charged weekly via direct debit
- Weekly fees are added to your account each Monday and processed via direct debit each Wednesday
- Fees are charged per week as part of an ongoing weekly membership, not per class attended
- EBA follows the WA school term calendar. Classes do not run during school holiday periods, and no fees are charged during these breaks.
- Your child's enrolment reserves their place in all allocated classes each week, regardless of attendance.
- There are no refunds for missed classes, absences, illness or change of mind.

Autopay Requirement

- All families must have valid autopay (direct debit) payment method on file
- Manual or advance payments may be made, but autopay remains mandatory.
- There is no surcharge or transaction fee for direct debit payments.
- You are responsible for ensuring your direct debit details are up to date via the Parent Portal.

4. Failed Payments & Overdue Accounts

If a weekly direct debit fails or a balance remains unpaid, EBA follows this process:

- Week 1 - Grace period: first notice sent; no late fee charged.
- Week 2 - Late fee: a \$15 late fee is added; final notice to settle before suspension.
- Week 3 - Automatic suspension: enrolment is suspended and classes cannot be attended until the balance (incl. late fee) is cleared.
- Week 4 - Debt collection warning: unpaid accounts may be referred to a Debt Collection Agency, incurring a 35% surcharge and associated costs payable by the account holder.

5. Annual Enrolment Fee

An Annual Enrolment Fee of \$55 per student is payable upon enrolment each calendar year.

This fee contributes to:

- Student insurance coverage
- Administrative and enrolment processing costs

The Annual Enrolment Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

6. Withdrawal & Refunds

To withdraw, two weeks' written notice must be submitted via email to info@ellenbrookballet.com. The notice period begins from the date the email is received. Weekly membership fees continue through the notice period, regardless of attendance. Withdrawals cannot be backdated. Your child may not attend classes once the notice period has concluded. Refunds are not provided for missed classes due to illness, holidays, or personal scheduling conflicts, or for change of mind. Fees are charged for enrolment in a class, not attendance at individual lessons.

7. Missed Classes & Cancellations

Missed classes are not refundable or transferable.

If a class is cancelled by EBA, a make-up class may be offered where possible.

Make-up classes are not guaranteed and cannot be credited, transferred, or used as a fee reduction.

8. Class Placement & Changes

Class placement is determined by age, experience, and training suitability.

EBA reserves the right to:

- Recommend appropriate class levels or training loads
- Adjust placements where required to support student development, safety, or class balance
- Class changes are not automatic and must be approved by EBA.

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9. Uniform & Grooming

At EBA we believe that wearing studio uniforms give students a sense of belonging to our team as well as creating an identity for our studio in the greater community. Ellenbrook Ballet Academy maintains a dress code to encourage concentration and a sense of inclusiveness. Uniformity in dancewear allows the teachers to assess how well the students are implementing the technique being taught, problems with alignment, and other important aspects of dance training including being able to spot students in skills safely. However, most importantly, it promotes studio pride, inclusiveness and a real sense of belonging.

Ballet classes: hair must be worn in a neat bun
Other styles: hair must be secured in a slick ponytail
No loose jewellery permitted

Uniforms and most dance shoes can be purchased year-round from the studio.

10. Child Collection & Supervision

Parents/guardians are responsible for collecting students immediately after class.
EBA does not provide supervision in the waiting area before or after classes.

11. Physical Contact

Parents acknowledge that appropriate physical contact may be required to assist with:

- Technique and alignment
- Demonstration of exercises
- First aid or injury support

All physical contact is professional and appropriate at all times.

Teachers are not to be contacted directly via personal channels.

13. First Aid & Medical Emergencies

In the event of illness or injury, EBA staff are authorised to administer first aid and/or contact emergency services. Any associated costs are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

14. Specialist Equipment Levy (Silks & Acro)

Students enrolled in Silks and/or Acro classes are required to pay a \$25 per term equipment levy. This levy contributes to equipment maintenance, safety inspections, and compliance requirements and is non-refundable once the term has commenced.

15. Suspension or Cancellation of Enrolment

EBA reserves the right to suspend or cancel enrolment where:

- Fees remain unpaid
- These Terms & Conditions are breached
- A student or parent fails to comply with reasonable directions issued by staff
- Behaviour compromises the safety, wellbeing, or positive culture of the Academy
- In EBA's discretion, continued enrolment is no longer appropriate

16. Applicable Law

These Terms & Conditions are governed by the laws of Western Australia and any applicable Commonwealth legislation.
