

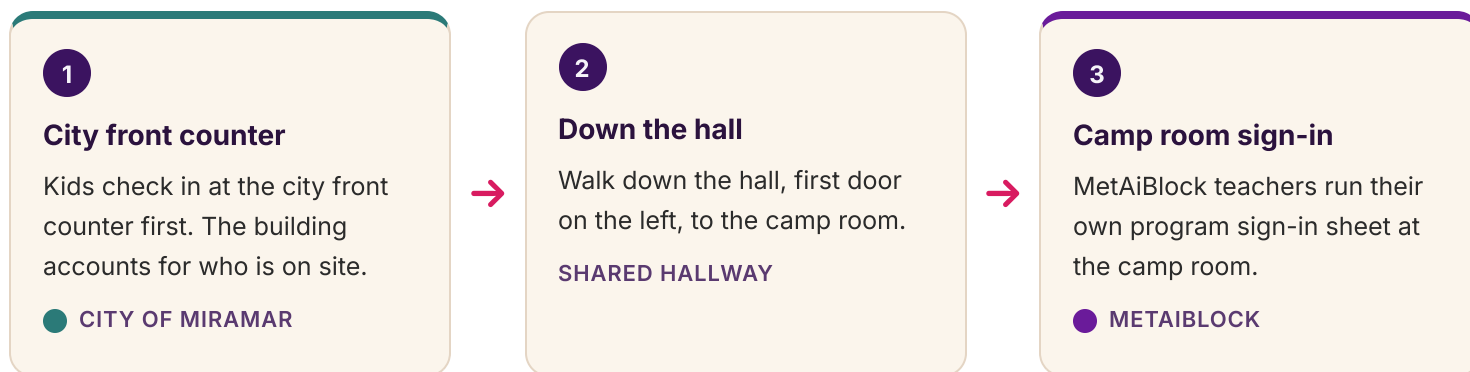
Camp Operations & Run-of-Day

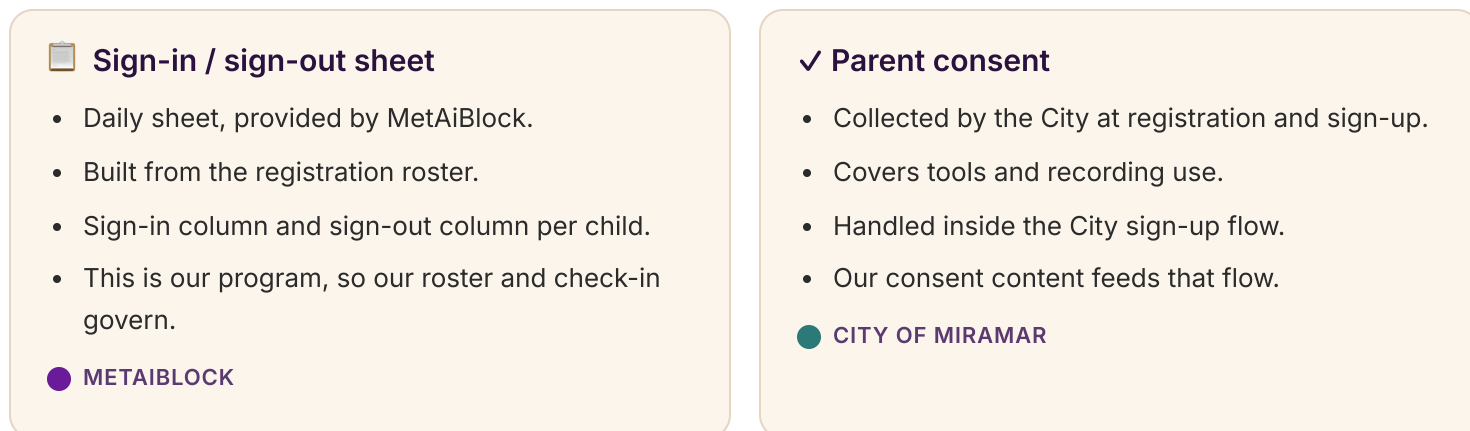
Who owns what

The daily release rules

Day 1 Every parent comes in and shows photo ID to be verified.

Ongoing The City keeps an authorized-pickup list per child.

Each day The parent signs the child out and speaks with the teacher at the door.

No valid ID or not on the list means no release.

Supervision



Kids are never out of the teachers' sight

MetAiBlock's Broward-certified teachers supervise the students the entire day. Small-group, always in view.

MetAiBlock is responsible for having its staff on site for the full period.



Bathrooms

- Kids are never out of the teachers' sight.
- Use the outside single-door bathrooms.
- Run scheduled group breaks.
- A teacher accompanies the group each time.

Lunch and breaks

- Scheduled set times each day.
- MetAiBlock provides the daily skeleton.
- The City retains \$1,000 of sponsor funds for food.
- Meal plan to confirm with the City.

● CITY FOOD · ● METAIBLOCK SCHEDULE

Daily skeleton (structure)

TIME	BLOCK	NOTES
9:00am	Arrival & sign-in	Front counter, then camp room. Teachers check the roster.
Morning	Build session 1	Hands-on project work, supervised in the camp room.
[Set time]	Group break	Scheduled bathroom break, teacher accompanies the group.
[Set time]	Lunch	Scheduled set time. Food per the City meal plan (to confirm).
Afternoon	Build session 2	Continued project work, supervised in the camp room.
[Set time]	Group break	Scheduled bathroom break, teacher accompanies the group.
3:00pm	Sign-out & pickup	Parent signs the child out and speaks with the teacher at the door.

The City is timeline-driven, so exact break and lunch times get locked before day one. MetAiBlock builds the daily skeleton with those set times.

Supervision and responsibility, split clearly

METAIBLOCK

Runs the program

- Broward-certified teachers supervise the students.
- Responsible for having its staff on site.
- Runs the program sign-in / sign-out sheet.
- Accompanies kids on every group break.
- Provides the daily break and lunch skeleton.

CITY OF MIRAMAR

Runs the building

- Front-counter check-in for the whole building.
- Collects parent consent at registration.
- Keeps the authorized-pickup list per child.
- Verifies photo ID on Day 1.
- Retains \$1,000 of sponsor funds for food.

Building context (who else is on site)

We share the building, not the room

Everyone signs in at the front counter. Our teens go to the camp room. Other programs run in their own spaces.
