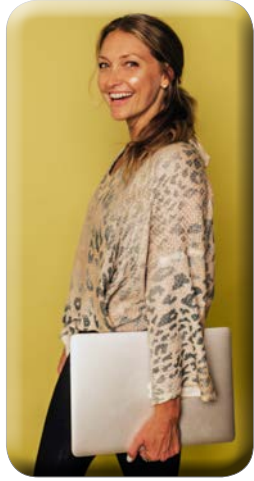


# Local Spotlight with Danielle: Gioia Concierge Offers Support to Community
