ORDER

On May 19, 2026, the petitioner Christian M. Capece, filed a petition seeking to voluntarily resign as a member of the West Virginia State Bar in accordance with Rule 3.26(a) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure. On June 16, 2026, the Investigative Panel of the Lawyer Disciplinary Board, by its chair Letitia Neese Chafin, filed its written report in accordance with Rule 3.26(c) of the Rules of Lawyer Disciplinary Procedure, recommending that the petition be granted.

Upon consideration and review, the Court of the opinion to, and does, grant the petition to voluntarily resign from the West Virginia State Bar.
