



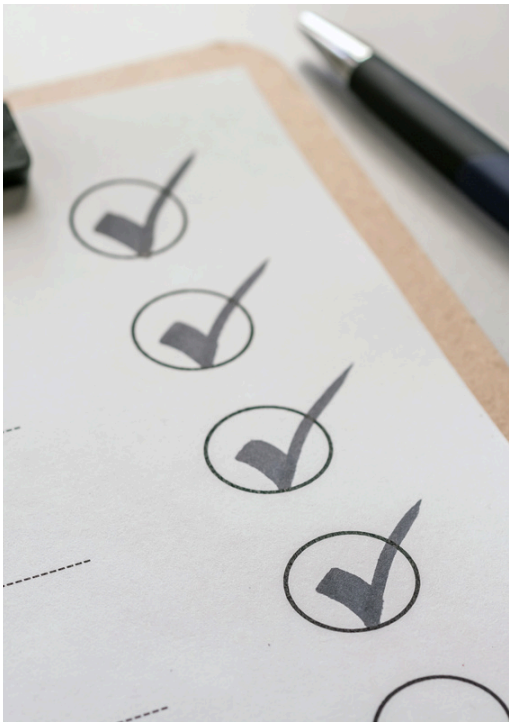

CONTINUITY CHECKLIST

Checklist Item	Yes	No
• Does the church have a written financial continuity plan?		
• Is the financial clerk trained and supported?		
• Are all financial records organized, accessible, and up to date?		
• Is there a documented process for transitions or resignations?		
• Does the church produce clear monthly financial statements?		
• Is there a separation of duties in financial roles?		
• Are passwords, logins, and financial access stored safely and shared appropriately?		
• Has the Pastor/First Lady's financial protection been addressed?		
• Do board members clearly understand their financial responsibilities?		
• Is the ministry prepared for sudden leadership transitions?		
• Are financial decisions documented and traceable for accountability?		
• Does the church have secure, audit-ready reporting?
