

What is the Basic Commercial Drivers Legal Plan?

The Commercial Drivers Legal Plan (CDLP) gives the driver the ability to help protect the way they earn their living.

Requirements and Eligibility

- Must be a US citizen or legal resident with a US address.
- Members are covered in all 50 states.*
- Not available in these states: New Jersey, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina and Virginia

Cost, Payment and Enrollment Method

- \$39.95 per month (enrollment fee).**** Group rates also available.
- Checking, savings, or credit card (No Prepaid cards). If added to a Group Authorization Card, plan can be billed with the group invoice.
- Enroll on WALS site, paper application, or group enrollment sites.

Details to Know

- Benefits have a 10-day waiting period.**
- Cannot sell in AK and MA.
- Members are covered in all 50 states. (Memberships cannot be sold in MA & AK)
- Spouse does not have to be a commercial driver.
- No personal or dependent related coverage. Only transportation related matters covered.
- Driver should enroll in a family legal plan for personal related and dependent coverage. If member enrolls in family legal plan, they will have two law firms. State Provider and CDLP Provider.

Coverage

- Tragic Accident Representation
- License Reinstatement
- Moving Violations
- DOT and Non-Moving Violations
- Property Damage and Personal Injury Collection
- CSA Consultation
- 25% Discount from Provider Law Firm's standard hourly rate for all other Transportation Related Legal Work

- OTR (Over the Road) Commercial Drivers
- Independent Owner Operators out of state

*Memberships cannot be sold in MA & AK.

**Any transportation related incidents in the first 10 days are available at a 25% Member's discount from the Provider lawyers hourly rate.
