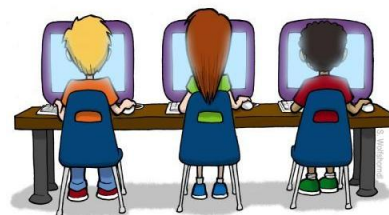

STTC Test Format

To perfectly mirror the official selective school exam, all sessions utilise a **computer-based** testing format.

- **Devices Provided:** All STTC sessions use the same computer-based testing format as the official selective school exam. Each student completes their trial test on an individual testing device provided by the college during class - no need to bring your own. This ensures every student has access to identical, properly configured equipment and can focus entirely on the test rather than troubleshooting their device.
- **Device Care Policy:** Students are expected to handle all testing devices with care throughout the session. Please remind your child of this responsibility. Parents and guardians are responsible for any repair or replacement costs if a device is damaged due to careless handling or negligence.

Make-Up Test Policy

If your child misses a scheduled class for any reason, they are welcome to complete a make-up test at our Penrith office **within one week of the missed session**. Make-up sessions are self-paced and allow students to complete the weekly test without falling behind on content coverage. However, please note that teacher-led interactive test reviews are not available during make-up sessions.

Fee Structure & Discount Offer

- Standard Course Fee: \$80 per session (week).
- Payment Terms: Tuition is payable in full before the term begins. For students enrolling mid-term, fees will be calculated pro-rata for all remaining sessions.
