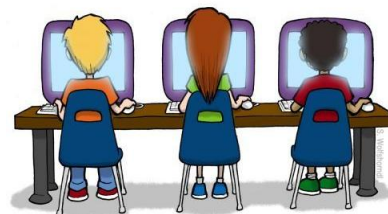

The Opportunity Class Placement Test is one of the most important academic milestones a Year 3 student will face. That's exactly what the OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC) is built for. The newly redesigned OCTTC has been updated to reflect the very latest OC placement test format, including full computer-based testing that mirrors the actual exam interface. From the question types and timing to the navigation and reporting, every aspect of the OCTTC is designed to make the real exam feel completely familiar when it arrives.

With weekly alternating sessions covering Reading and Mathematical Reasoning & Thinking Skills, and detailed progress reports via Cyberschool, students don't just practise, they improve in measurable, trackable ways that parents and students can both see clearly.

Class Timetable

OCTTC Test Format

To perfectly mirror the official OC exam, all OCTTC sessions utilise a **computer-based** testing format.

- **Devices Provided:** All OCTTC sessions use the same computer-based testing format as the official OC exam. Each student completes their trial test on an individual testing device provided by the college during class - no need to bring your own. This ensures every student has access to identical, properly configured equipment and can focus entirely on the test rather than troubleshooting their device.
- **Device Care Policy:** Students are expected to handle all testing devices with care throughout the session. Please remind your child of this responsibility. Parents and guardians are responsible for any repair or replacement costs if a device is damaged due to careless handling or negligence.

Make-Up Test Policy

If your child misses a scheduled class for any reason, they are welcome to complete a make-up test at our head office **within one week of the missed session**. Make-up sessions are self-paced and allow students to complete the weekly test without falling behind on content coverage. However, please note that teacher-led interactive test reviews are not available during make-up sessions.

Fee Structure & Discount Offer

- Standard Course Fee: \$80 per session (week).
- Payment Terms: Tuition is payable in full before the term begins. For students enrolling mid-term, fees will be calculated pro-rata for all remaining sessions.
- **Special Bundle Discount:** Enrol in both the full-term OCTTC and WEMT courses together at the same branch to unlock a discounted rate of \$72 per session for the OCTTC! (Note: WEMT course fees are charged separately).
