NAPLAN Trial Test Course (NTTC)

A new NAPLAN Trial Test Course (NTTC) will be available to Year 5 students, which will be 6-week course providing three (3) NAPLAN trial tests for assessment of knowledge and test performance.

The NAPLAN trial test will be conducted in a **computer-based format (CBT)** requiring students to use computers provided in the classroom.

By taking the course, students will be able to practise NAPLAN style questions under exam conditions and learn how to manage their test time efficiently, minimise errors, overcome exam nerves.

It will help them to build their confidence to succeed in the 2026 NAPLAN tests in March. Please check out the course schedule below.

This program will aid students in improving their writing skills for all written assignments at school, as well as writing exams for selective high school placement and independent school scholarship exams.

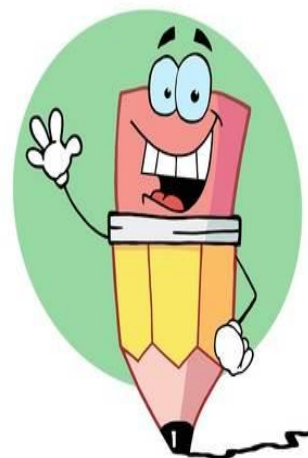
