UNITED WE PLEDGE GOLF CLUB

Constitution & By-laws

Article I

*The name of this golf club shall be the **UNITED WE PLEDGE GOLF CLUB**.*

Article II

PURPOSE

FIRST: *To stimulate interest in UNITED WE PLEDGE by bringing together a group of golfers desirous of forming a golfing organization while supporting youth civics education initiatives.*

SECOND: *To promote and foster among the members a closer bond and fraternity for their joint and mutual benefit, and to promote and conserve the best interests and true spirit of the game of golf as embodied in its ancient and honorable traditions.*

THIRD: *To encourage conformance to the USGA Rules of Golf by creating a representative authority.*

FOURTH: *To maintain a uniform system of handicapping as set forth in the Utah Golf Association/USGA Handicap System and issue Utah Golf Association/USGA Handicap Indexes to the members.*

FIFTH: *To provide an authoritative body to govern and conduct club competitions.*

Article III

MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Membership shall be available to all (men/ women) (18) years of age or older and some select Juniors. There shall be a minimum of 10 members in the club.*
- 2. All Memberships are NON-EQUITY. Memberships in the club are individual and non-transferable. Dues include membership in the Utah Golf Association (UGA). The UGA provides a subscription to the quarterly magazine (UGA Golf), monthly computerized handicap updates, UGA tournament eligibility and other special membership services available. All members of this club will be registered for UGA membership.*
- 3. Only golfers with a reasonable opportunity to play golf with fellow members and who can personally return scores for posting may be members and receive UGA/USGA Handicap Indexes from the club.*
- 4. Memberships in the club are annual memberships. For simplicity of accounting for membership payment to UGA, memberships will expire on the last day of the previous quarter originally registered for the first year only, except for the original joining members, which will use September 1, 2026 as their Anniversary Date.*
- 5. The Annual Cost of Membership is \$200.00*



except for those that have current USGA/UGA handicaps at another Golf Club, then their annual fee is \$165.00.

6. *The fiscal year for the club shall be from July 1-June 30.*
7. *All Memberships are NON-EQUITY and have no other expressed interest, stock or membership value.*
8. *The Board of Directors may confer honorary memberships upon those whom they feel have contributed to the advancement of golf and the community. The unanimous affirmative vote of the board shall be required to approve such action.*
9. *In the event that any member of the club shall commit any act which reflects discredit or disrepute thereon, or shall refuse or neglect to comply with the rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Directors or the duly appointed officers, such member shall be subject to suspension or expulsion after ten days written notice and the right to be heard, by a vote of two thirds of the Board of Directors at any regular meeting called for such purpose.*
10. *The annual meeting of the United We Pledge Golf Club shall be held on the third Wednesday in the month of October. The Board of Directors shall provide for the holding of such other meetings as may be deemed necessary or desirable and they shall call special meetings upon written petition signed by not less than ten percent of the membership.*
11. *A legal quorum at any meeting shall be ten members present in person or by proxy. Each*

active member in good standing shall be entitled to one vote.

12. *All membership fees and dues shall be established by the Board of Directors from time to time in such amounts as they deem to be adequate to operate and maintain the club. Members shall be liable for dues until their written resignation has been received and accepted or at the annual anniversary of their membership original application. All monies collected shall accrue to the benefit of the membership.*

Article IV

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. *The Board of Directors shall consist of 3 members in good standing of the United We Pledge Golf Club and they shall exercise all powers of management of the club not specifically excepted by these By-laws.*
2. *In the case of any vacancy through death, resignation, disqualification or other cause, the remaining directors, even though less than a quorum, may elect a successor by majority vote to hold office for the unexpired term of the director whose place shall be vacant, and until the election of his successor.*

Article V

OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

1. *Within ten days after the Annual Meeting and election, the Board of Directors shall meet and elect the officers.*
2. *The officers shall consist of president, vice-*



president, secretary/treasurer, and their duties shall be such as their titles would indicate or such as may be assigned to them respectively from time to time.

3. The Board of Directors shall authorize and define the powers and duties of all committees. Chairman and members of all committees shall be appointed by the president, and the president shall be an ex-officio member of all committees.
4. Except as modified by the Board of Directors, all appointed committees shall function as recommended in the USGA Golf Committee Manual. The Following Committees shall be appointed each year, with such other committees as the president may deem necessary or advisable:

- **Tournaments Committee** to arrange and schedule with the management of any golf course as necessary, and conduct all intra-club and inter-club competitions including UGA qualifying events.
- **Handicap Committee** composed primarily of members with the responsibility to establish a fair and proper system of handicaps in accordance with procedures set forth in the UGA/USGA Handicap System Manual.
- **Social Committee** to encourage and arrange

social entertainment features and events for special occasions.

- **Sponsorship Committee** will seek out and solicit sponsors for tournaments and events

Article VI

AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

The Board of Directors shall have the power to repeal or amend any of these By-Laws.





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
