Start with the operating model

Ask which work should become faster, which decisions should become better, which coordination should become more visible, and which risks need stronger controls. Strategy is a change in how work is organized, not merely the addition of a chatbot.

Five useful layers

1. **Models** — reasoning, generation, and multimodal capabilities.
2. **Tools** — retrieval, code execution, APIs, browsers, and connectors.
3. **Workflows** — the repeatable sequence that turns inputs into outcomes.
4. **Interfaces** — where people review, approve, correct, and receive results.
5. **Systems** — data, permissions, evaluation, costs, and operating ownership.

Decision questions

- What is the smallest workflow worth improving?
- What evidence will tell us that quality improved?
- Where must a person approve or correct the result?
- What data and permissions are actually required?
- What is the cost of failure and the cost of running the system?

Avoid trend-driven decisions

Separate a capability signal from a product announcement, a demo from a production result, and a forecast from an established fact. Record the date and source of time-sensitive claims.
