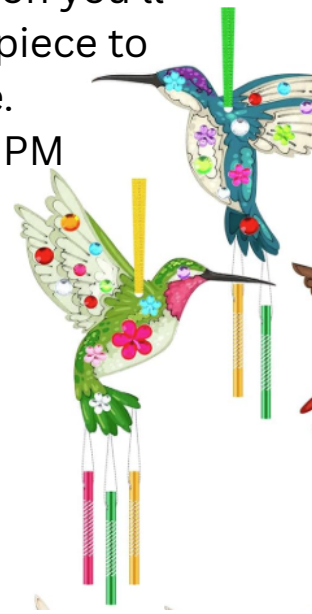

Kentucky Derby: Almost always held on the first Saturday of May.

Symbols and Nature

Name Origin: Named after Maia, the goddess of spring and growth
Birthstone: The emerald, which represents love and success.

Birth Flowers: The Lily of the Valley (symbolizing sweetness/return of happiness) and the Hawthorn (symbolizing hope).

Full Moon: Known as the Full Flower Moon, representing the blooming of flowers.
