The Mack Lewis Foundation is committed to reducing juvenile delinquency and combating community deterioration in the Church Square community (Baltimore City 21205). Through food assistance, youth programs, education, health services, and mentorship, we create safe spaces and opportunities for children and families to thrive.



FOOD SECURITY & FAMILY SUPPORT

When the only grocery store in the Church Square community closed, hundreds of low-income families were left in a food desert.

Over **50,000 LBS OF FOOD** & FRESH PRODUCE provided to families in need.

More than **500 FAMILIES** served **TWICE A WEEK** (Tuesdays & Fridays).

For the last **7 years**, distributed over **350 TURKEYS EACH YEAR**.

Hot Holiday meals provided to families in need.

Due to the shut down of SNAP in November 2025, we served more than 1000 families with food distribution by adding another day.

Creating positive experiences and lasting memories for over 5,000+ children and youth in the Church Square community.

Serving over 70 youth with fun, learning, and free breakfast & lunch.

WORKSHOPS & TRAINING Sessions on leadership, financial literacy, and career readiness helping youth prepare for successful futures.



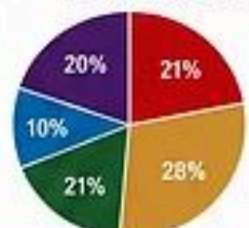
COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS & WELLNESS
