- Integrity: Do what is right, even when no one is watching.
- Respect: Honor coaches, teammates, opponents, umpires, and the game itself.
- Accountability: Own your actions, words, and commitments.
- Excellence: Strive to be your best in effort, attitude, and skill development.
- Faith: Lead and live with Christ as your example, shining your light for others.

Player Agreement

As a player in Ambassadors Baseball, I agree to:

1. Hustle at all times as defined by The Ambassadors Way.
 2. Be coachable and open to instruction.
 3. Willingly play multiple positions as needed for the team.
 4. Maintain a team-first attitude.
 5. Wear Ambassadors Baseball uniforms properly and professionally.
 6. Avoid profanity on and off the field while representing the program.
 7. Respect coaches, teammates, parents, opponents, and umpires.
 8. Never argue with an umpire or display negative body language.
 9. Never throw equipment in frustration.
 10. Accept discipline without attitude and learn from it.
 11. Attend all team practices and tournaments unless excused.
 12. Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
 13. Avoid fighting, drugs, alcohol, and performance-enhancing substances.
 14. Conduct myself professionally in hotels and dorms, obeying curfews.
 15. Keep hair groomed; no jewelry or facial hair during events.
 16. Show appreciation to coaches, parents, and umpires after events.
 17. Arrive on time for all team functions.
 18. Complete the Player Video Training course before attending events.

Parent Agreement

As a parent of an Ambassadors Baseball player, I agree to:

1. Conduct myself in a way that reflects The Ambassadors Way.
 2. Never root against the other team or argue with umpires.
 3. Avoid profanity at all events.
 4. Speak to the coaching staff only about my child, privately.
 5. Avoid public negative comments about other players, parents, or coaches.
 6. Avoid second-guessing coaching decisions publicly.
 7. Refrain from giving coaching tips during games.
 8. Follow rules regarding uniform wear in public.
 9. Do not carry player equipment to/from events.
 10. Follow team hotel and travel policies.
 11. Stay current on all financial obligations.
 12. Avoid public intoxication.
 13. Complete the Parent Video Training course before attending events.

Coach Agreement

As a coach with Ambassadors Baseball, I agree to:

1. Coach all players equally, without bias, in accordance with The Ambassadors Way.
2. Prepare players for success on and off the field.
3. Teach dignity, class, character, and discipline.
4. Be respectful; never intentionally embarrass a player.
5. Strive for excellence and accept nothing less than the best effort.
6. Respect families' time; be punctual and organized.
7. Be honest about each player's role and position.
8. Maintain confidentiality; discuss players only with the player or parents.
9. Work to get players recognition and exposure to higher levels.
10. Never use profanity in public or in the presence of players/families.
11. Give honest, accurate player evaluations.
12. Be accountable for my actions and coaching decisions.
13. Complete a verified background check.
14. Avoid contacting former players for one year after leaving.
15. Be accountable for the actions of players and parents.
16. Commit to 100% of the team schedule unless excused.
17. Implement Ambassadors Baseball-approved style of play.
18. Enforce all program policies consistently.
19. Avoid public confrontations with anyone while representing the program.
20. Organize fellowship or faith-building opportunities during travel events.

21. Avoid alcohol in public while representing Ambassadors Baseball.

22. Lead by example in all interactions, promoting The Ambassadors Way.

23. Complete the Coach Video Training course before attending events.
