- Research addressing emerging infectious diseases and diseases of special concern in the region.

Immunization Programs and Public Health Impact

- Effective implementation of large-scale vaccination campaigns.
- Programs that significantly reduce vaccine-preventable diseases.
- Strategies for improving immunization coverage.

Community Engagement and Advocacy

- Advocacy campaigns promoting vaccine awareness and acceptance.
- Initiatives addressing vaccine misinformation and hesitancy.
- Engagement with local communities to improve vaccine literacy.

Digital Health and Technology
