| 4 | Will participating cost our program anything? | No, there is no monetary cost to participate. Your site completes a quality assessment, receives educational resources, and a stipend as part of participation. |
| 5 | How will this impact our workflows? | We believe there will be minimal disruption: <ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Study is designed to fit real-world practice◦ There are no mandated workflow changes required◦ Tools and resources are available at your own pace |
