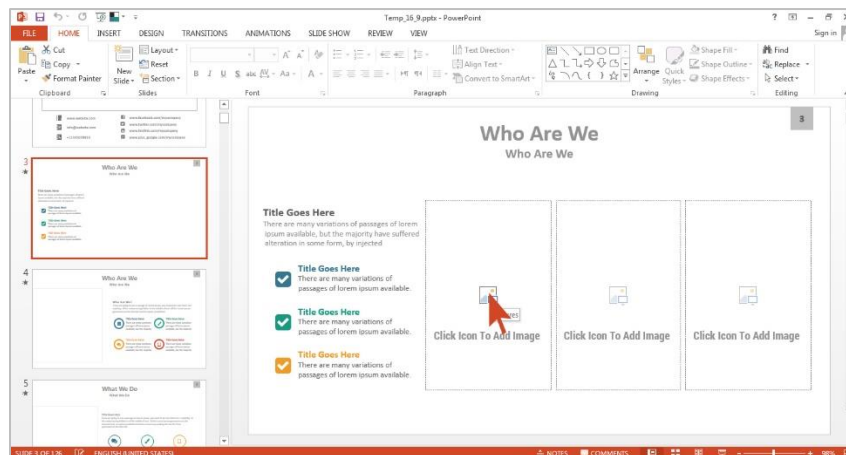

Please Note that the Image holder are ready to use , *Just Drop and Drop your image into image holders* or click on the icon in the middle of image holder and add your photos and images , the image and photo will fit directly into the shape . No need to use any other program, as shown below:



How to install the color themes?

In the color themes folder you will find 90 theme as *.XML file. You simply can add all of them to your PowerPoint directly. As shown below:



To let color schemes always show up in your “Custom” area in the Design tab Colors drop-down in PowerPoint:

- 1- First go to “*Assistant Folder*” Folder that came with your download, then open “*Theme Colors*” Folder.
- 2- *Select* all XML Files in “*Theme Colors*” Folder, *Copy* them.
- 3- Add all the XML files inside this folder (Please note that I have demonstrated where is the theme folder on your computer for each System you use)
- 4- **For Windows XP:**
C:\Documents and Settings\[*your user name*]\Application Data\Microsoft\Templates\Document Themes\Theme Colors
- 5- **For Windows vista:**
C:\Users\[*your user name*]\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Templates\Document Themes\Theme Colors
- 6- **For Windows 7:**
C:\Users\[*your user name*]\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Templates\Document Themes\Theme Colors
- 7- **Windows 8, Windows 8.1, Windows 10:**
C:\Users\[*your user name*]\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Templates\Document Themes\Theme Colors
OR
Add them to: C:\Program Files\Microsoft Office\Document Themes 15\Theme Colors
- 8- **For Mac OS:**

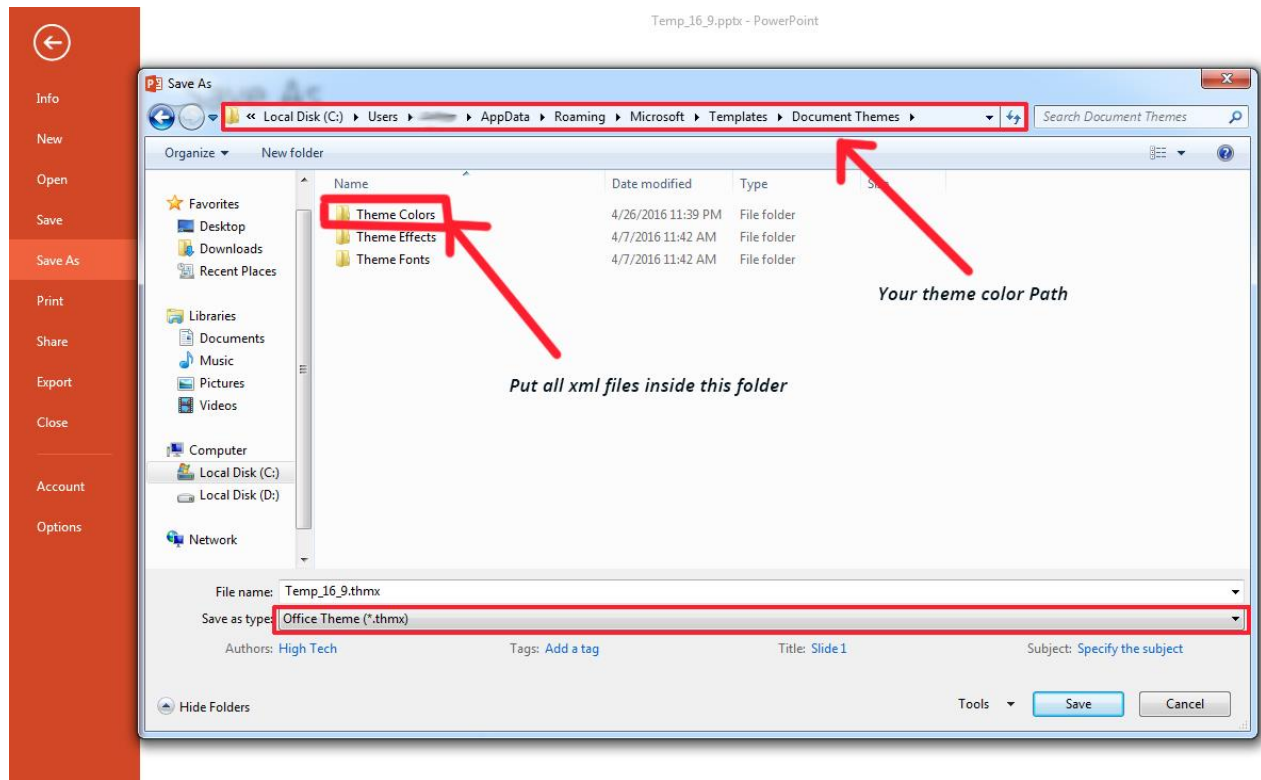
- 9- Users > [your user name] > Library > Application Support > Microsoft > Office > User Templates > My Themes > Theme Colors folder.

The Library folder is not visible by default in some Mac OS, you can make it visible by:

Run Terminal application (You'll find Terminal in the Utilities folder inside the Applications folder), paste this command into the Terminal window and then press Return: `chflags nohidden ~/Library/`

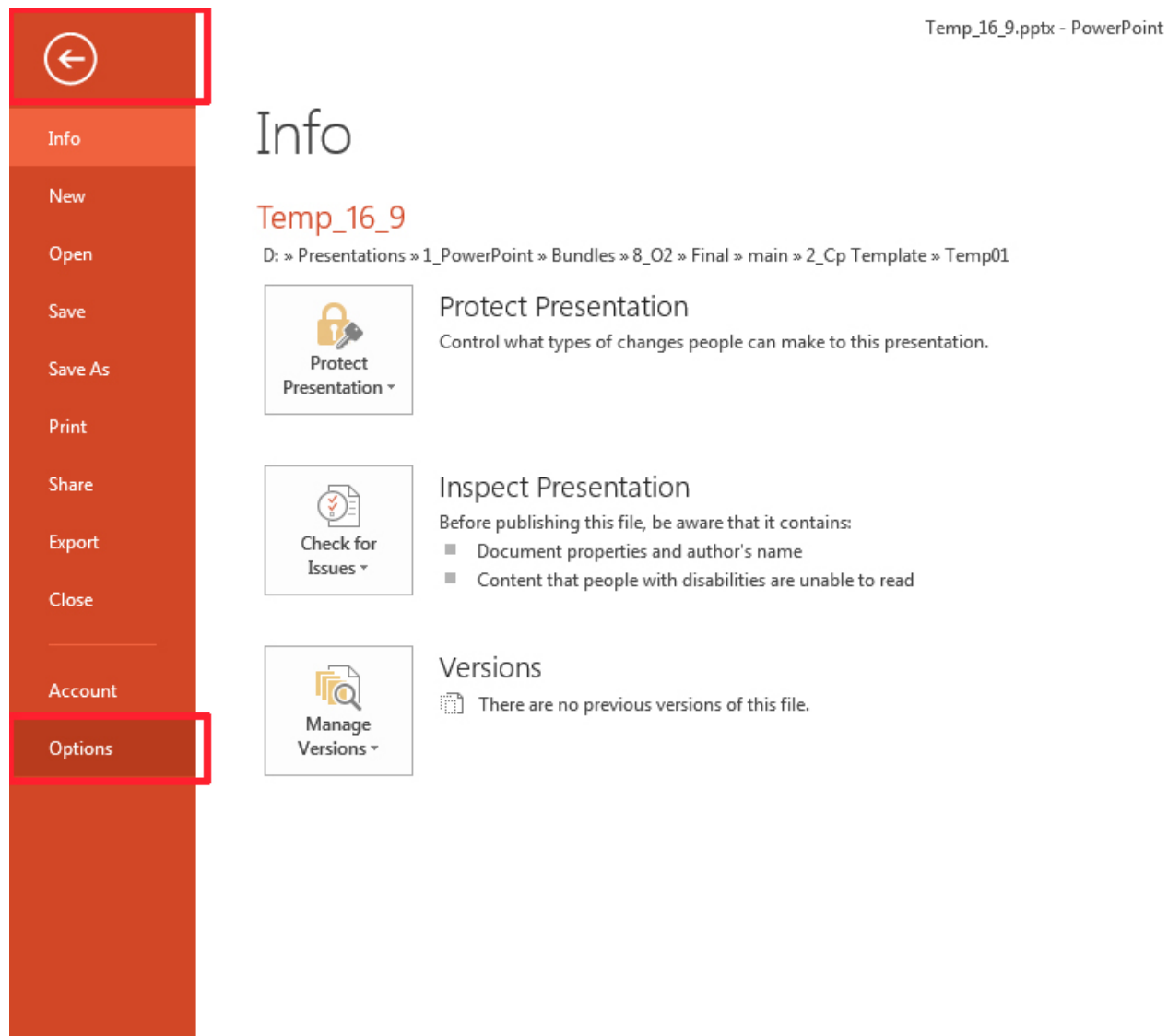
You can then quite the Terminal Application and you will find the Library folder where you expected it in the User directory.

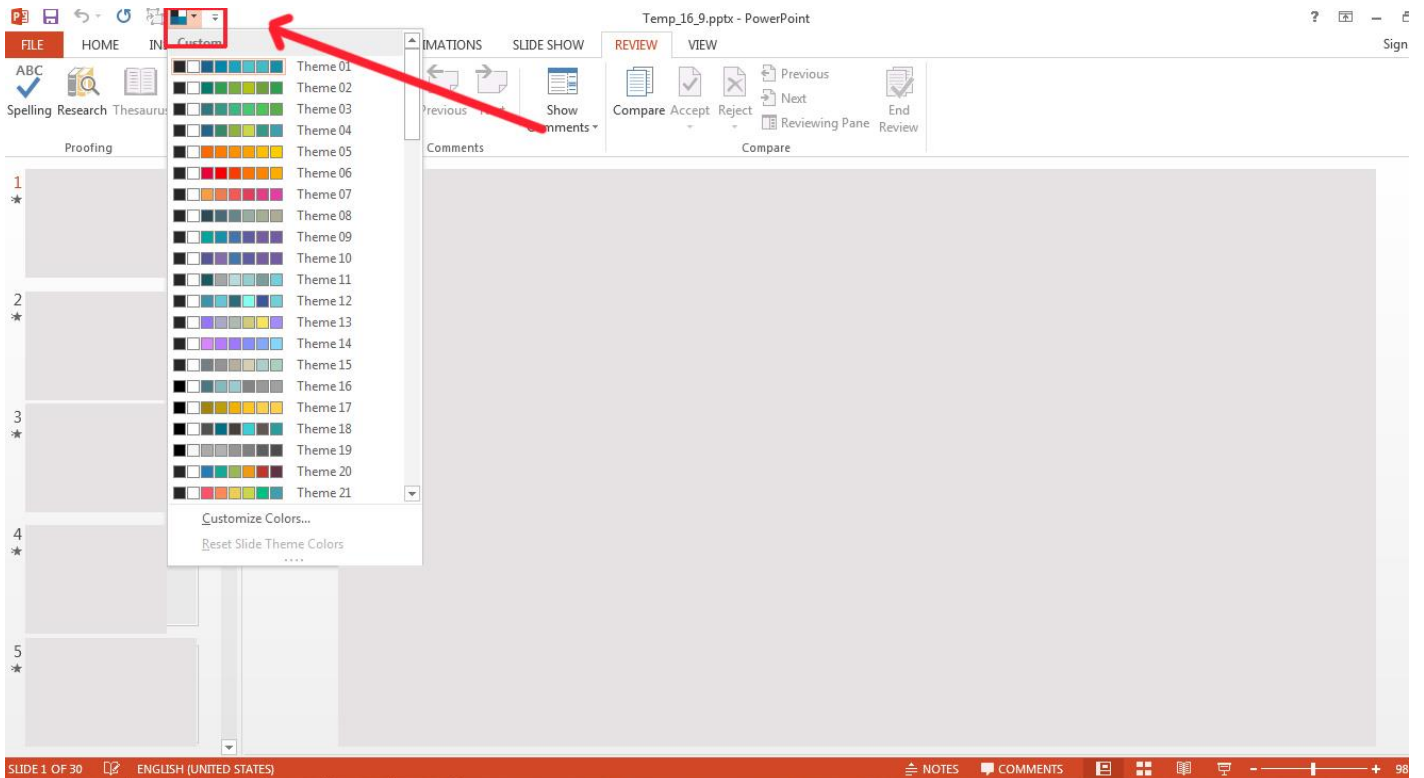
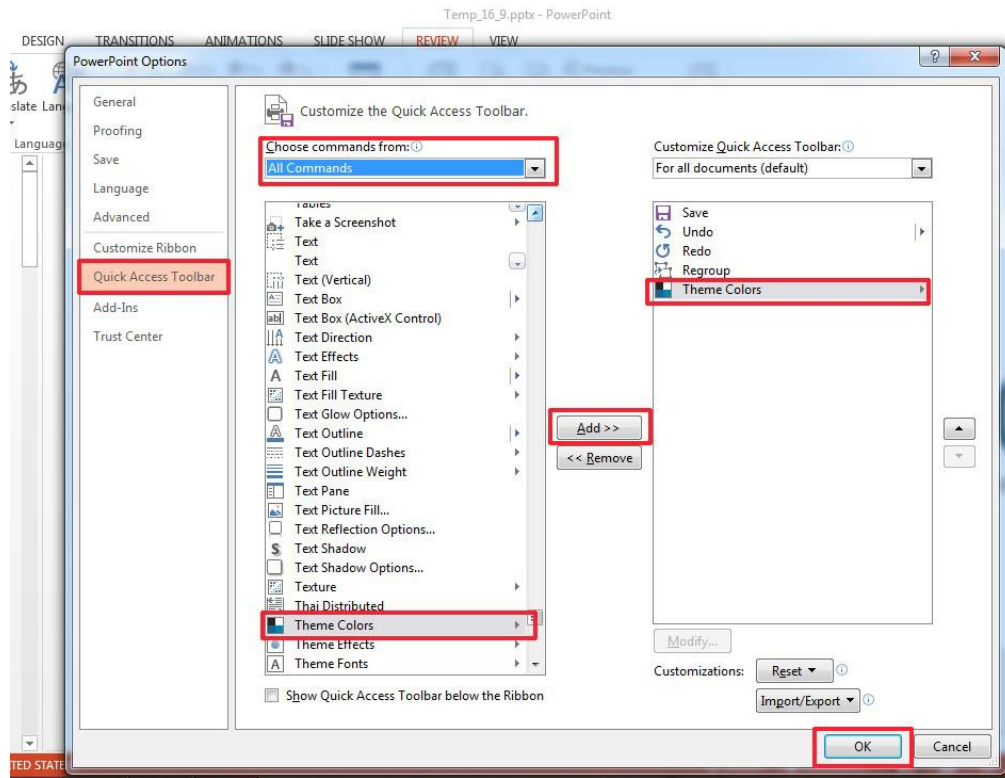
**If you can't find the path of theme folder, you can try this trick
Open PowerPoint, any file, then save as *.thmx, then you will find path to your theme color, as shown below image**



Once you add the color themes, you will find all of them in your PowerPoint directly as shown below

- 1- To have a quick access to your color theme palette
Please follow these instructions :
- 2- Go the “ Options “ – Quick access toolbar - Choose command from (All commands) – Search for “ Color themes “ Press “Add>>” . Then you will have the color theme in the top-left bar. As shown below:
