Frequently Asked Questions

Why a Vintage Division?

The Vintage Division was created to give players aged 60 and older additional opportunities to play competitive baseball beyond AZMSBL's traditional spring and summer seasons.

What is the relationship between AZMSBL and the Vintage Division?

The Vintage Division operates under the AZMSBL umbrella.

AZMSBL provides:

- League registration & fee collection
- Spring and summer league operations
- Player waivers
- Schedules, statistics and standings
- Administrative support

The Vintage Division manages:

- Player recruitment & registration
- Winter league tryouts
- Team formation
- Draft management



Who can join the 60+ Vintage Division?

You are eligible if:

- You turn 60 years old by December 31 of next year.
- You have a completed or updated profile on the AZMSBL web site. You pay the \$100 registration fee by October 31 and the team fee by November 30 (the \$100 registration fee applies toward your team fee).
- You have the basic skills and strong desire to play baseball.

What do the fees cover?

- Each team pays a winter league fee that covers field rentals, umpires, baseballs, insurance and league operations; team managers collect each player's share of the team fee before the season starts.
- The \$100 registration fee covers tryout fields and equipment while validating players' sincere interest in participating.

How do Vintage Division games differ from standard AZMSBL games?

- Rules of play for Vintage Division closely mirror [AZMSBL rules](#) with potentially minor variations to accommodate senior players.

What if I haven't played in many years?

- If you have basic skills and a desire to play, we invite you to join the fun.
- What you can expect:
 - ⊖ 9-inning games played on regulation fields with two umpires.
 - Weekly weekday day-games played in central locations throughout the Phoenix area.
 - A mix of veteran and rookie players with varying skill levels.
 - A solid community of like-minded men with a passion for baseball.
- What equipment will you need to play:
 - Your own glove, bat and helmet.
 - ⊖ Baseball shoes (metal cleats, molded rubber or turf shoes)
 - Baseball uniform – your manager will provide instructions.
