

## Rapids Raptors Cheerleader – Code of Conduct

I hereby understand and agree to the following:

- I will abide by the rules, guidelines and policies set forth by Rapids Raptors Youth Football and Cheerleading Association (RRYFCA) and applicable league rules as set forth by the Central Wisconsin Youth Football Association.
- I understand that football and cheerleading are team sports.
- It is my responsibility to be a contributing /responsible team member by:
  - Attending ALL practices and arriving on time.
  - Doing well in school academically.
  - Giving 100% and participating to the best of my ability during games and practices; and
  - Showing loyalty and dedication to my team.
  - Understanding that every Cheerleader is important to the success of the team; and
  - I will learn my routines/cheers to the best of my ability and effort, and I will practice extra if needed.
- I will be responsible for caring for the Cheerleading equipment issued to me.
- I will always bring all my cheerleading equipment (Poms/Uniform) to practice and games unless instructed otherwise by the coach.
- I will avoid all unnecessary “fooling around” and unsafe behavior at practices and on the sidelines during games.
- I will show respect for my coaches, teammates, football players, cheerleaders, officials, my opponents, RRYFCA volunteers, and myself always.
- I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, fellow teammate, cheerleader, opponent, RRYFCA volunteer, spectator, or parent, such as booing, taunting and refusing to shake hands.
- I will not use profanity, abusive language, or obscene gestures.
- I will refrain from fighting with any person. Fighting will NOT be tolerated.

I agree and understand that if I fail to abide by the above rules and guidelines, or engage in any other conduct that my coach or the RRYFCA Board deems to be detrimental to my team or the organization, I will be subject to disciplinary action, which could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by the coach, official, Director of Cheerleading and/or President of the RRYFCA.
- Cheerleader game or games suspension, with written documentation of incident kept on file with the RRYFCA Board.
- Cheerleader season suspension (full or part) as determined by the RRYFCA Board.
- Loss of family veteran status for the following year’s registration; and/or
- Expulsion from the organization as determined by the RRYFCA Board.
