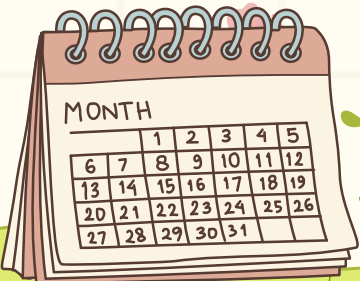
A Season of Growth and New Beginnings!
