

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to modishgifts.com, AngelaCooper.com NuFocus Realty & Consulting Group, NuFocus Consulting Group LLC, and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to NuFocus Consulting Group LLC includes nufocusuniversity.com and NufocusU.com are ecommerce sites. By using any of the included websites and or real estate services or training programs, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”), if you are a resident of the European Economic Area (“EEA”), we process your personal information under the following lawful bases:

In order to better provide you with products and services offered, NuFocus Consulting Group may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- Mailing Address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number

If you purchase Modish Gifts's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

Any of our mentioned websites may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

- Age
- Location

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services. These may include: (a) registering for an account; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing products and services. To wit, we will use your information for, but not limited to, communicating with you in relation to services and/or products you have requested from us. We also may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Automatic decision-making

If you are a resident of the EEA, you have the right to object to processing based solely on automated decision-making (which includes profiling), when that decision-making has a legal effect on you or otherwise significantly affects you.

We *do* engage in fully automated decision-making that has a legal or otherwise significant effect using customer data.

Our processor Shopify uses limited automated decision-making to prevent fraud that does not have a legal or otherwise significant effect on you.

Services that include elements of automated decision-making include:

- Temporary blacklist of IP addresses associated with repeated failed transactions. This blacklist persists for a small number of hours.
- Temporary blacklist of credit cards associated with blacklisted IP addresses. This blacklist persists for a small number of days.

Use of your Personal Information

NuFocus Consulting Group collects and uses your personal information to operate and deliver the services you have requested.

NuFocus Consulting Group may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from NuFocus Consulting Group and its affiliates.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

NuFocus Consulting Group does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

NuFocus Consulting Group may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to NuFocus Consulting Group, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

NuFocus Consulting Group may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on NuFocus Consulting Group or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of NuFocus Consulting Group; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of NuFocus Consulting Group, or the public.

Tracking User Behavior

NuFocus Consulting Group may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within NuFocus Consulting Group, in order to determine what NuFocus Consulting Group services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within NuFocus Consulting Group to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by NuFocus Consulting Group. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the

operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the NuFocus Consulting Group website.

Use of Cookies

The Modish Gifts website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Modish Gifts pages, or register with Modish Gifts site or services, a cookie helps Modish Gifts to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. Security of your Personal Information

Right to Deletion

Subject to certain exceptions set out below, on receipt of a verifiable request from you, we will:

- Delete your personal information from our records; and
- Direct any service providers to delete your personal information from their records.

Please note that we may not be able to comply with requests to delete your personal information if it is necessary to:

- Complete the transaction for which the personal information was collected, fulfill the terms of a written warranty or product recall conducted in accordance with federal law, provide a good or service requested by you, or reasonably anticipated within the context of our ongoing business relationship with you, or otherwise perform a contract

- between you and us;
- Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity; or prosecute those responsible for that activity;
 - Debug to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality;
 - Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law;
 - Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act;
 - Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when our deletion of the information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, provided we have obtained your informed consent;
 - Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with us;
 - Comply with an existing legal obligation; or
 - Otherwise use your personal information, internally, in a lawful manner that is compatible with the context in which you provided the information.

Children Under Thirteen

NuFocus Consulting Group does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.

E-mail Communications

Changes to this Statement

NuFocus Consulting Group reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by sending a notice to the primary email address specified in your account, by placing a prominent notice on our website, and/or by updating any privacy information. Your continued use of the website and/or Services available after such modifications will constitute your: (a) acknowledgment of the modified Privacy Policy; and (b) agreement to abide and be bound by that Policy.

If you are located in Canada, this section applies to you.

We may process your information if you have given us specific permission (i.e. • express consent) to use your personal information for a specific purpose. or institutions where your permission can be inferred (i.e. • implied consent). In some exceptional cases, we may be legally permitted under applicable law to process your information without your consent. including, for example:
