I'm Lorraine, a teacher turned founder of Let's Pass. We run small-group GCSE tuition in Maths, English and Science, built on the idea that consistent, expert teaching beats last-minute cramming every time. Groups are small, 4 to 8 students, grouped by ability, and led by tutors who know their subject inside out. Many of our team are examiners or senior leaders in schools. A lot of our parents take more than one subject with us, which tells you what they think of the teaching. We're careful about who joins the team, because the standard of tuition is the whole business.

The role

- Self-employed contractor role, invoiced half-termly
- Weekly GCSE English group of 4 to 8 students, following Havering term dates (no sessions in school holidays, unless you choose to run Year 11 holiday revision)
- Delivered online via Zoom
- £12.50 per student per group session, or £35 per hour for 1:1 where that's needed
- Sessions run after school and at weekends in term time, so you'll need to be free at those times each week
- We're looking for tutors who can commit for the full academic year, so students get consistency rather than a revolving door of teachers

What you'll be doing

- Teaching GCSE English Language and Literature to a mixed-ability group, building both exam technique and genuine confidence in reading and writing
- Planning your own lessons and using your own resources, tailored to where your group actually is, not a generic scheme of work
- Setting homework that actually informs what you teach next, not homework for its own sake
- Keeping useful records of progress and flagging anything a parent needs to know, early

- Managing day-to-day questions from parents and students via WhatsApp
- Staying current with GCSE English specification changes

What we're looking for

- QTS, and real classroom experience you can point to
- Examiner or senior leadership experience is a strong plus
- Comfortable running a group, not a series of 1:1s side by side. Managing different personalities and ability levels in one session is part of the job, and it's part of what makes Let's Pass work
- Able to work independently and get things done without being chased
- Direct, honest communication, including with parents when the conversation isn't easy

- Confident with Zoom, Gmail and Google Drive; TutorBird experience is a bonus
