LIVESTOCK PRODUCER ANIMAL HANDLING AFFIDAVIT

As a customer of livestock to Park Ranch Harvest ("Processor"), you must follow our guidelines. Processor always require the proper care and humane handling of livestock throughout the supply chain with a consistent, proactive approach to meeting the needs of a healthy animal and quality product. All producers must follow the Code of Care. Mistreatment of livestock will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Producers must abide by the following Code of Care:

- Provide necessary food, water, and care to protect the health and well-being of livestock.
- Provide disease prevention practices to protect herd health, including access to veterinary care.
- Provide facilities that allow safe, humane, and efficient movement and/or restraint of livestock.
- Provide personnel with training and/or experience to properly handle and care for livestock.
- Make timely observations of livestock to ensure basic needs are being met.
- Minimize stress when transporting livestock.
- Abuse or rough handling of animals is not permitted. Excessive use of electric prods is prohibited. The use of some electric prods may be necessary at times but should not be abused or overused.
- Non-ambulatory animals will not be accepted at any Processor facility or affiliate facility.
- Distressed livestock, those that are debilitated, ill or otherwise compromised should not be delivered/supplied to Processor.
- Dead on arrival livestock will not be offloaded.
- Abide by humane handling practices when loading or unloading livestock at any at any Processor facility or affiliate facility.
