Dr Simon Abram is a Consultant Knee Surgeon at North Bristol NHS Trust and Senior Lecturer at the University of Bristol, with specialist expertise in soft tissue knee surgery, joint preservation, cartilage and meniscal surgery, osteotomy, arthroplasty, and sports-related injuries. He has over 15 years of orthopaedic experience and a PhD (DPhil) in Musculoskeletal Sciences from the University of Oxford.

He has authored more than 40 peer-reviewed publications, including in The Lancet, The BMJ, and The Bone & Joint Journal, and has presented widely at international and national conferences. Dr Abram also serves as Specialty Editor for Knee for the Bone & Joint Research.

His medico-legal expertise includes CPR-compliant reporting across trauma and orthopaedics, with experience in claimant, defendant, and joint instructions. He has participated in joint expert meetings and will provide oral evidence in court. His medico-legal practice is supported by structured CPD, including Bond Solon and Expert Witness Institute training.
